The Missouri Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse has prepared this Thirteenth Edition of the *Status Report on Missouri's Alcohol and Drug Abuse Problems*. This annual report includes data tables and charts that identify and illustrate alcohol and drug abuse trends and consequences.
