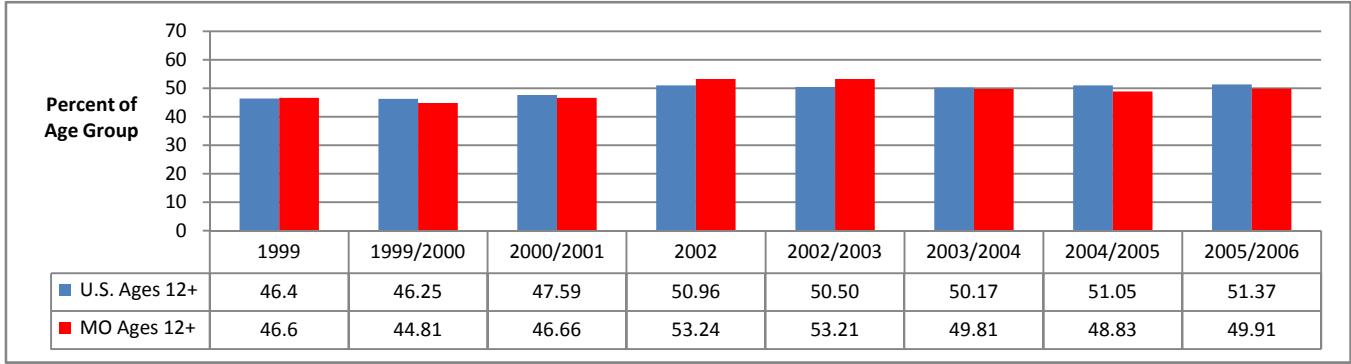

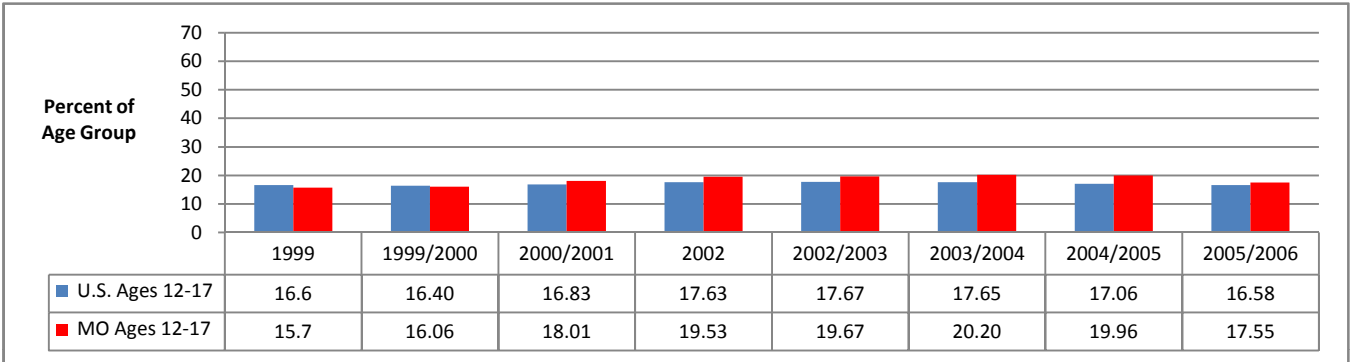

Estimated Past-Month Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 and Older, 1999-2006



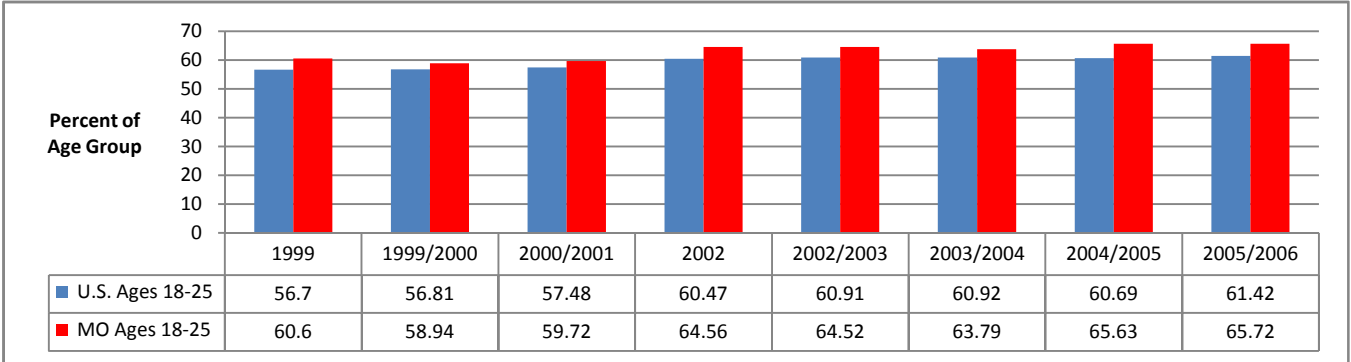

Estimated Past-Month Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



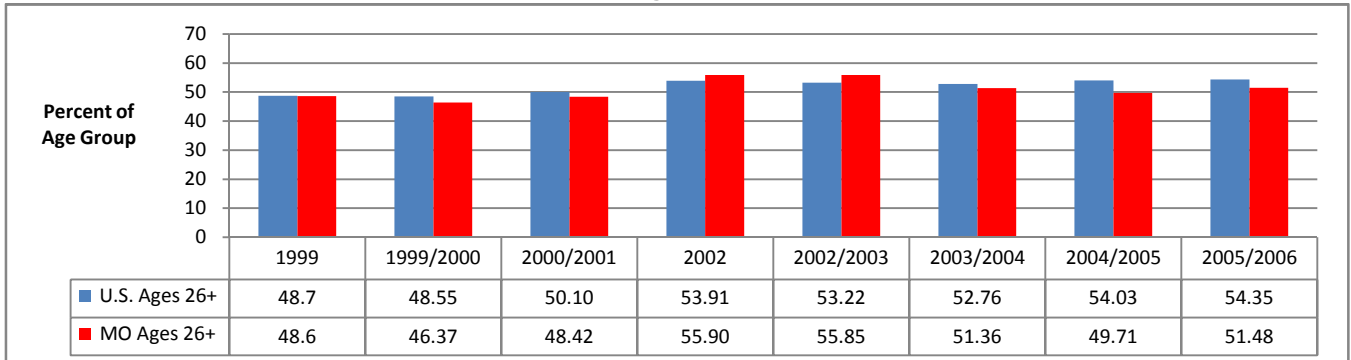

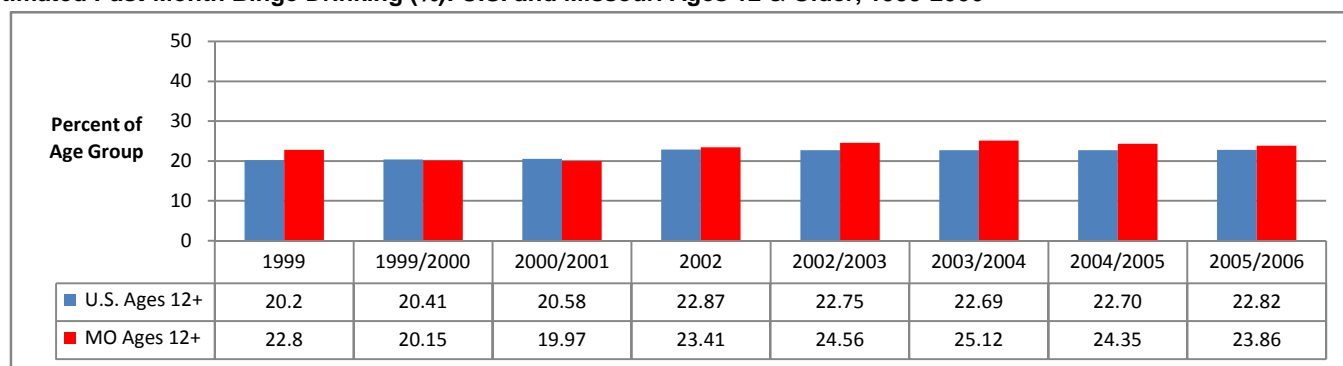
Estimated Past-Month Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

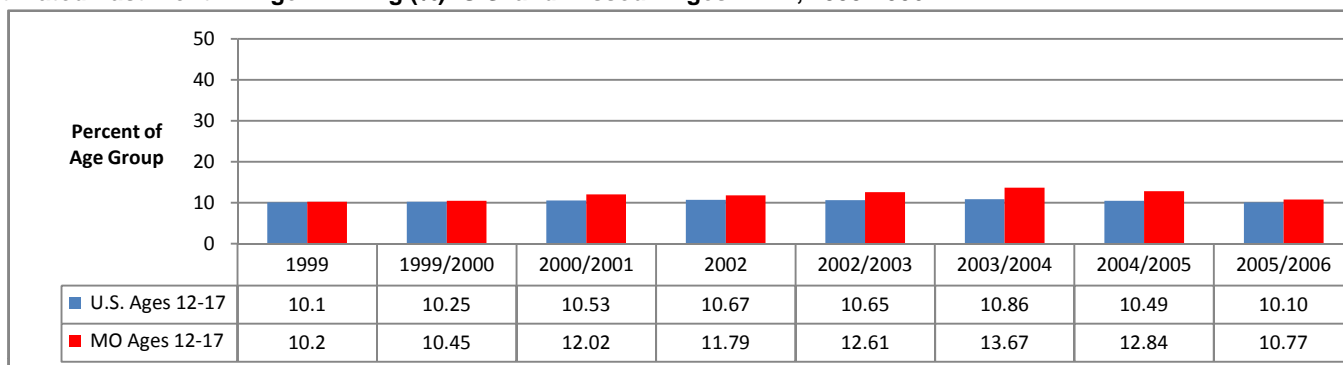

Estimated Past-Month Binge Drinking (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



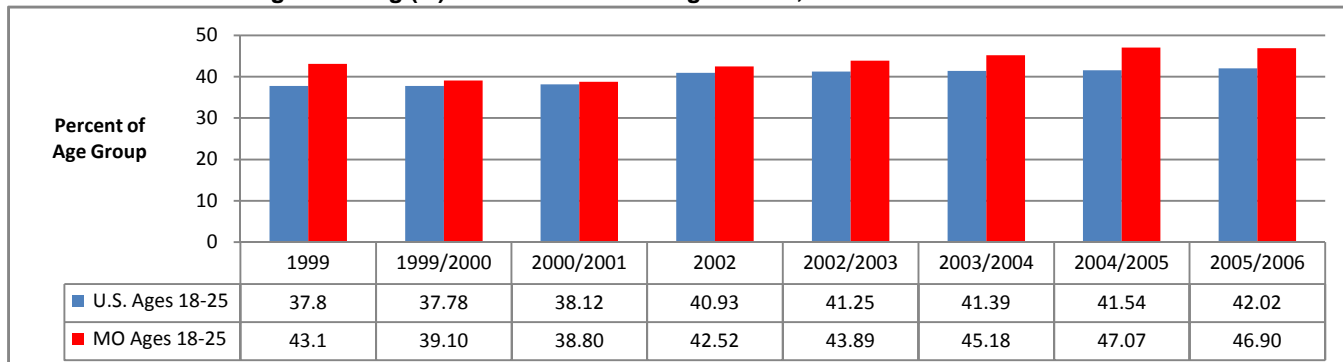

Estimated Past-Month Binge Drinking (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



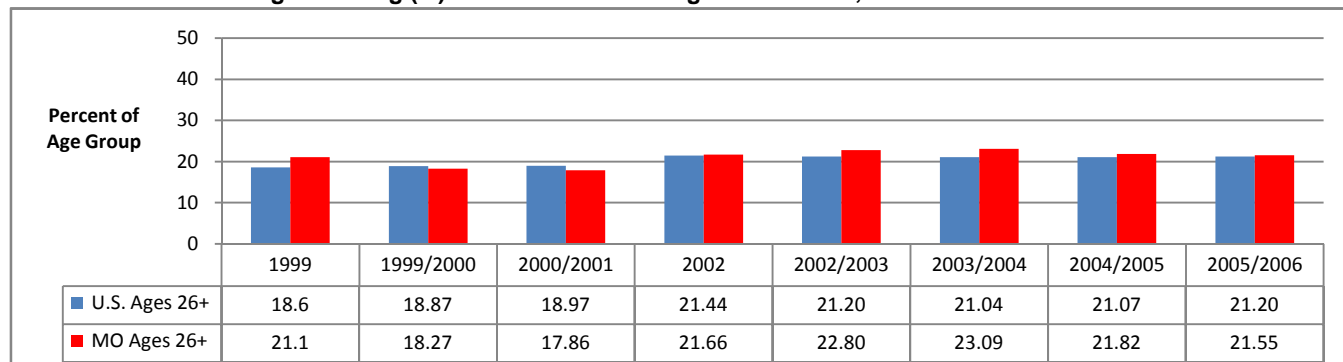

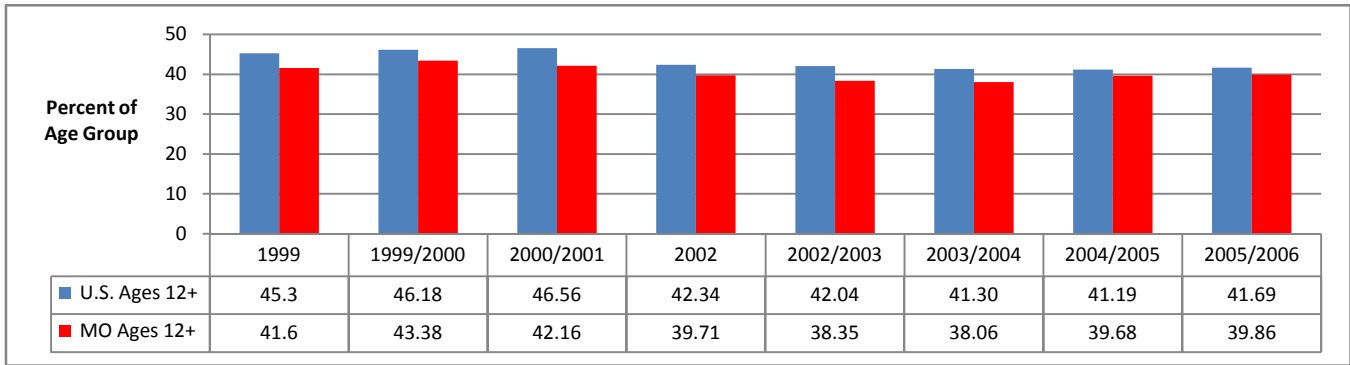
Estimated Past-Month Binge Drinking (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

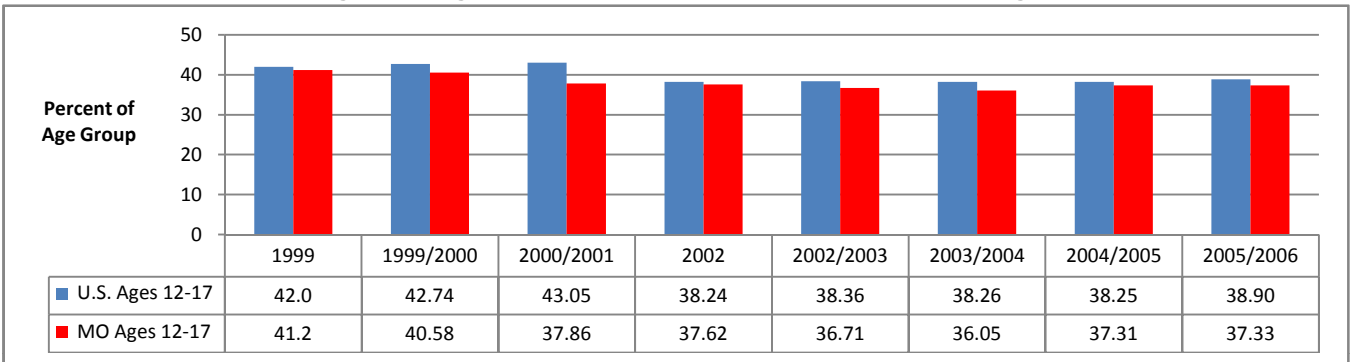

Perceptions of Great Risk of Binge Drinking 1 or 2 Times per Week (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



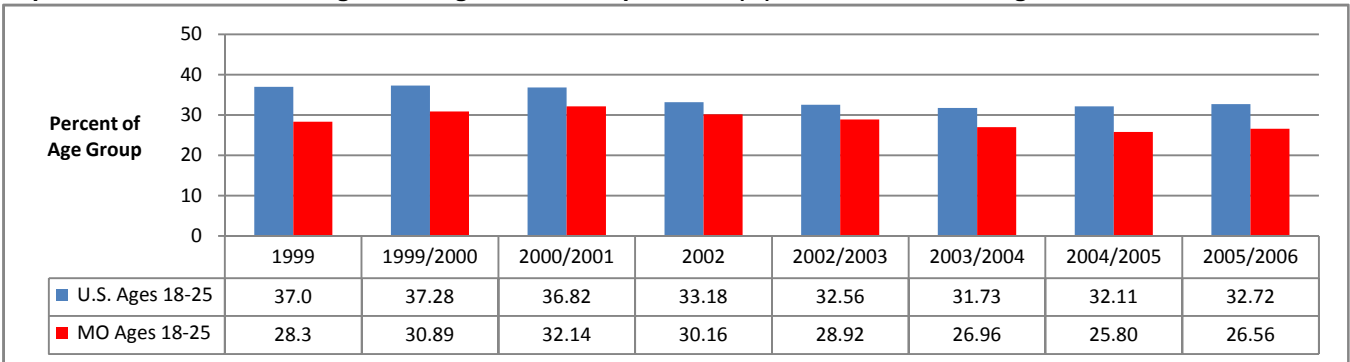

Perceptions of Great Risk of Binge Drinking 1 or 2 Times per Week (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



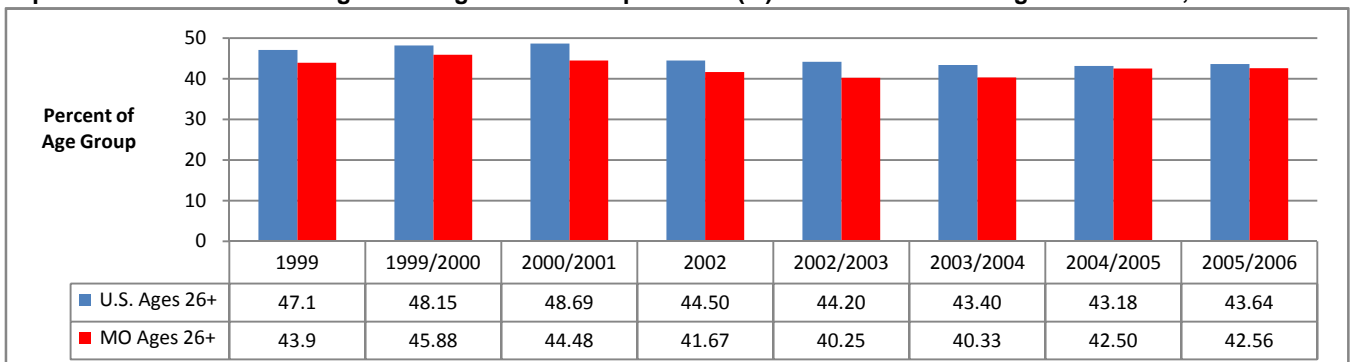

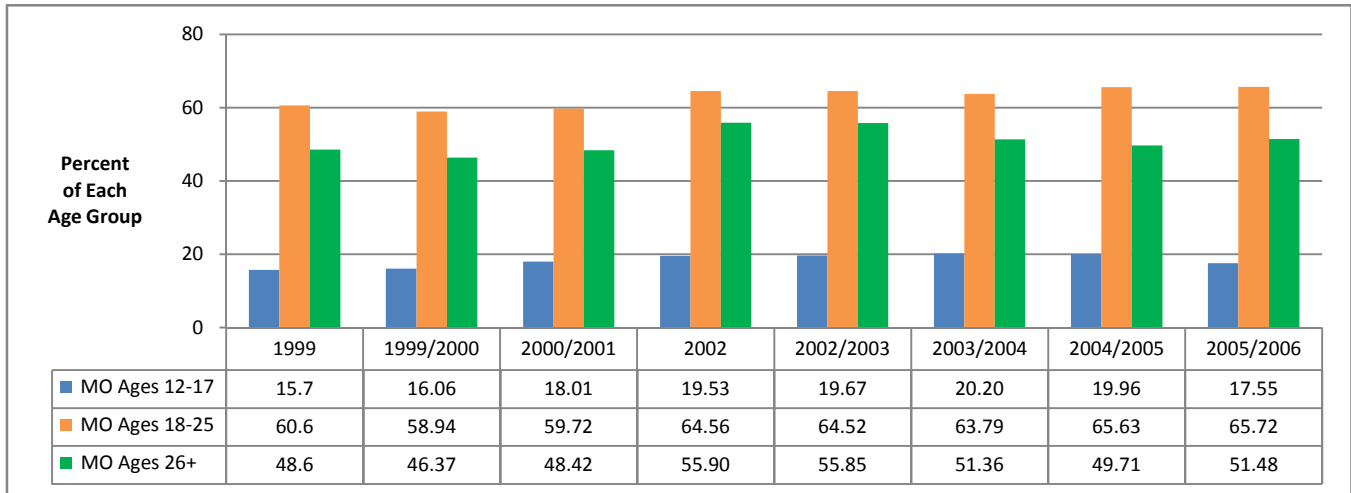
Perceptions of Great Risk of Binge Drinking 1 or 2 Times per Week (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

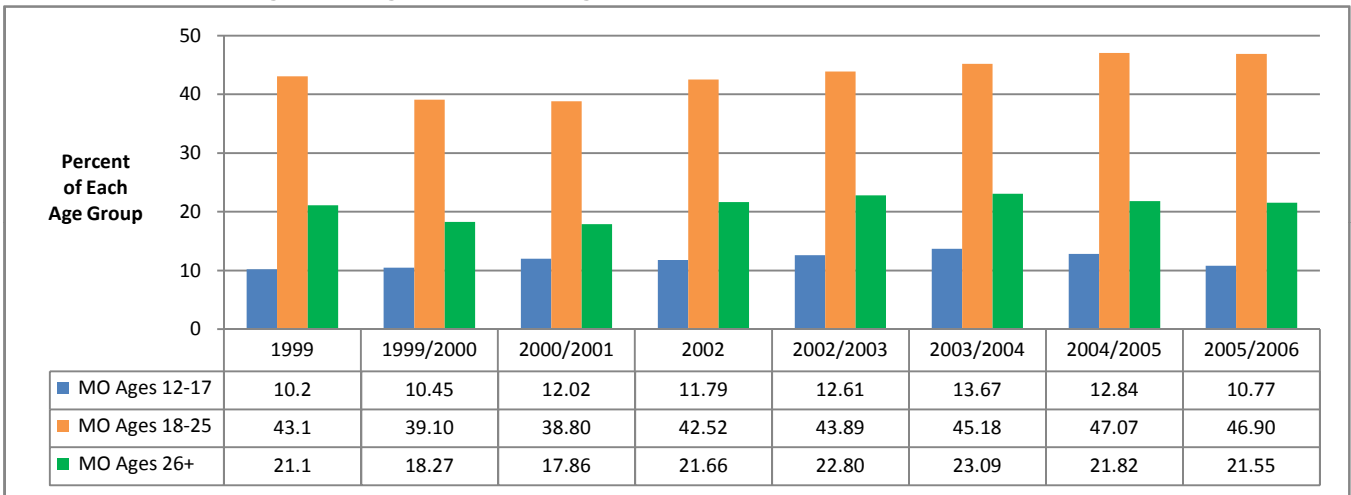

Estimated Past-Month Alcohol Use (%): Missouri Age Group Comparisons, 1999-2006



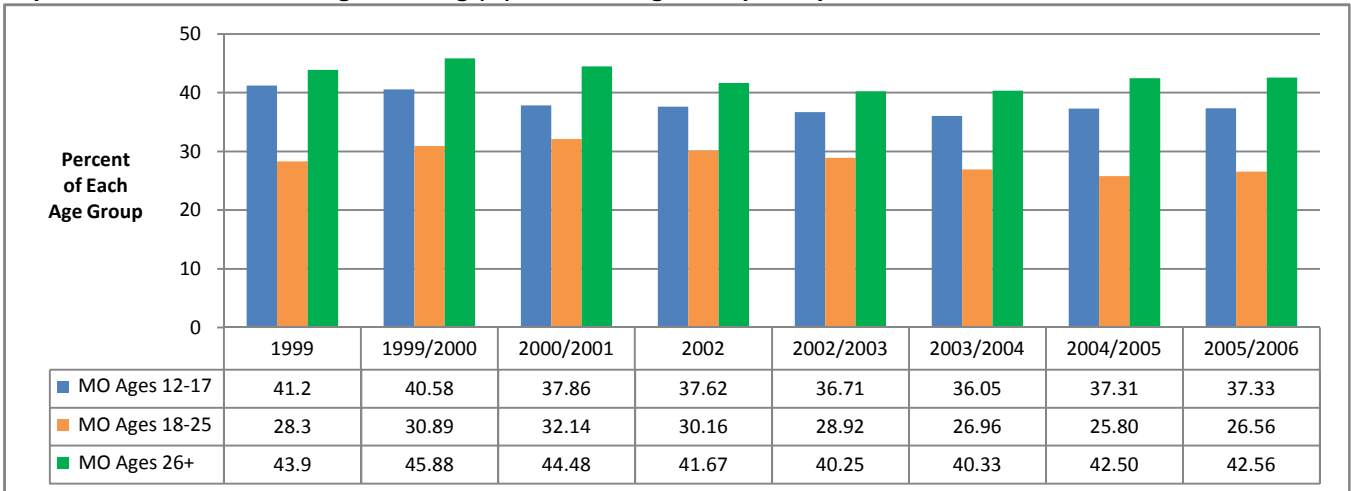

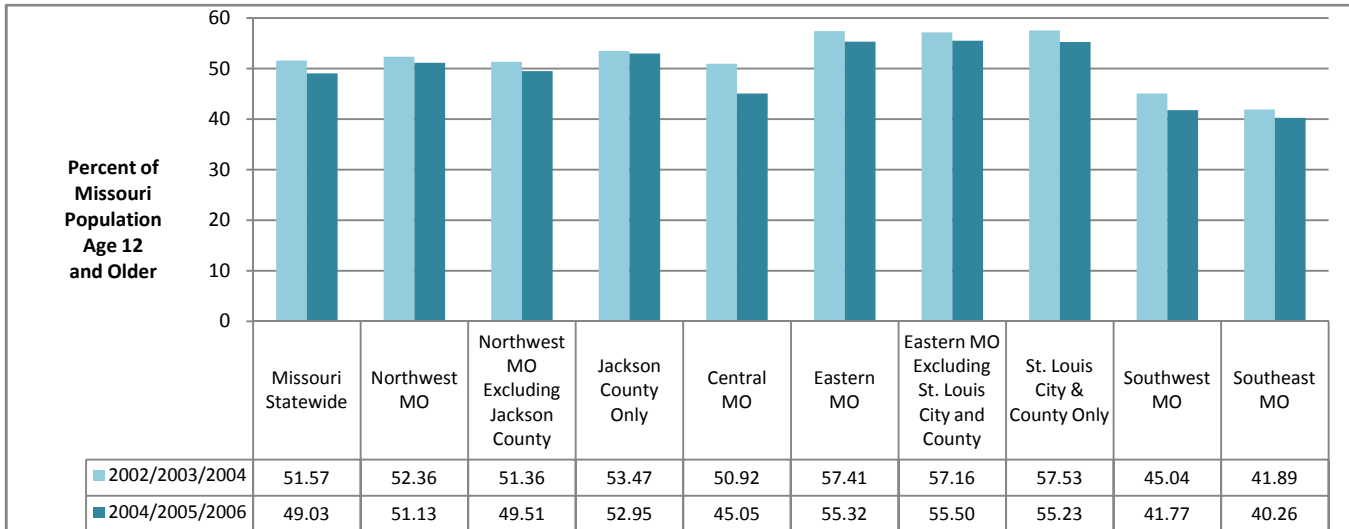
Perceptions of Great Risk of Binge Drinking (%): Missouri Age Group Comparisons, 1999-2006

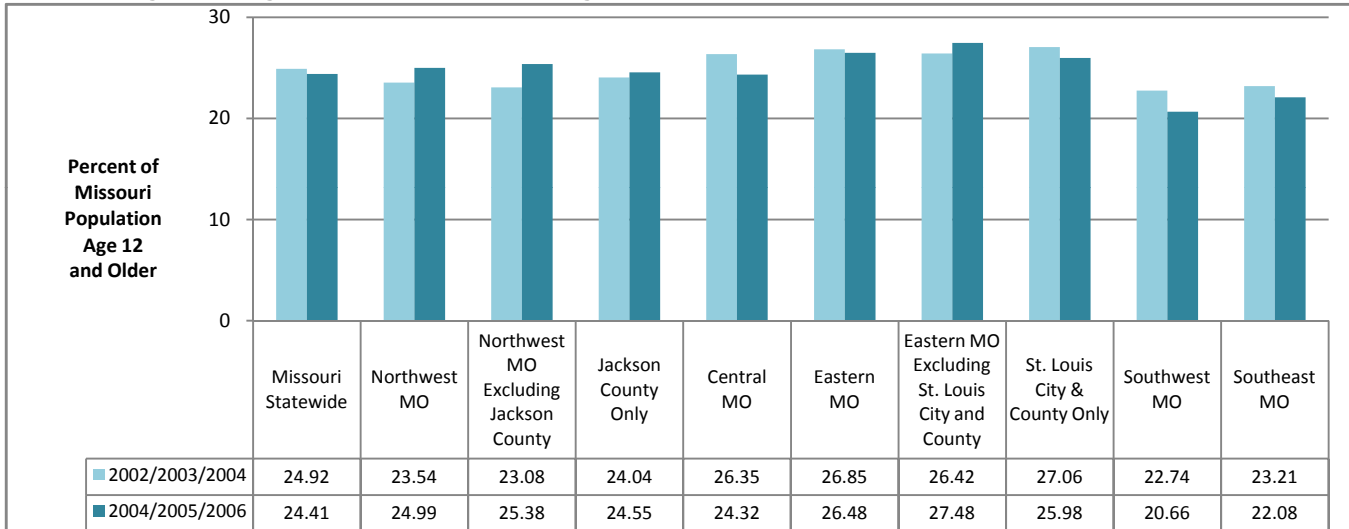

Past-Month Alcohol Use (%): Missouri and ADA Regions for Combined Years



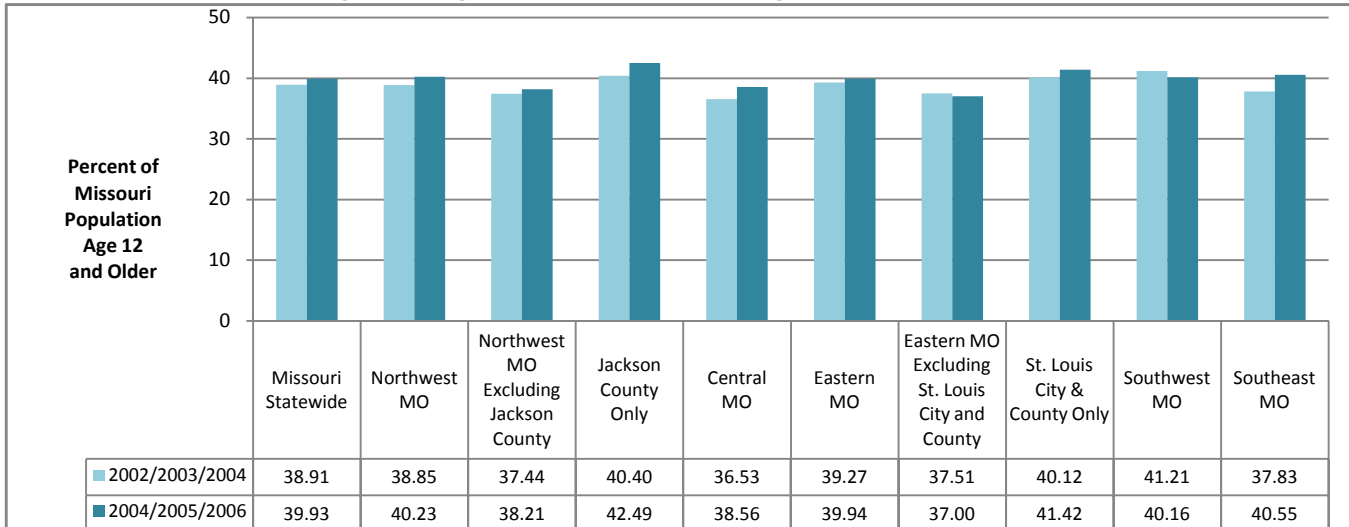

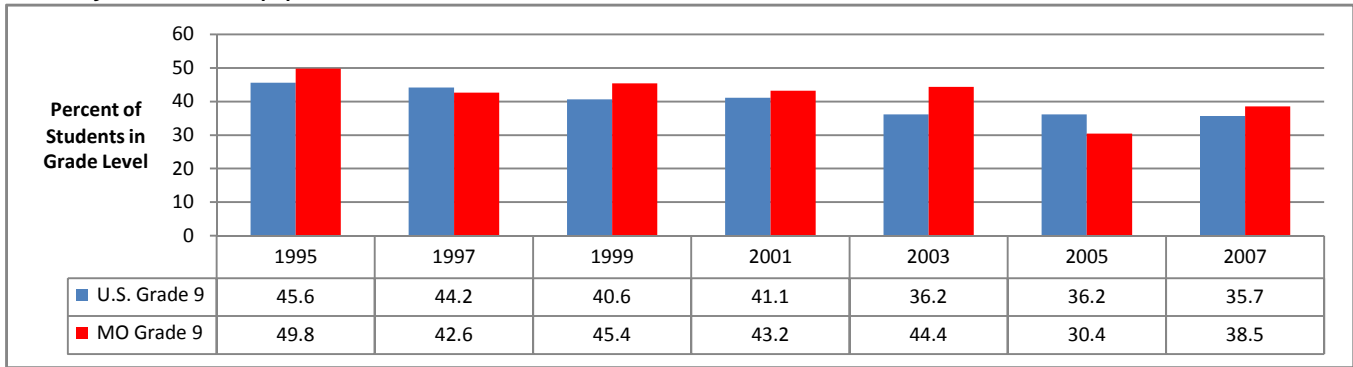
Perceptions of Great Risk of Binge Drinking (%): Missouri and ADA Regions for Combined Years

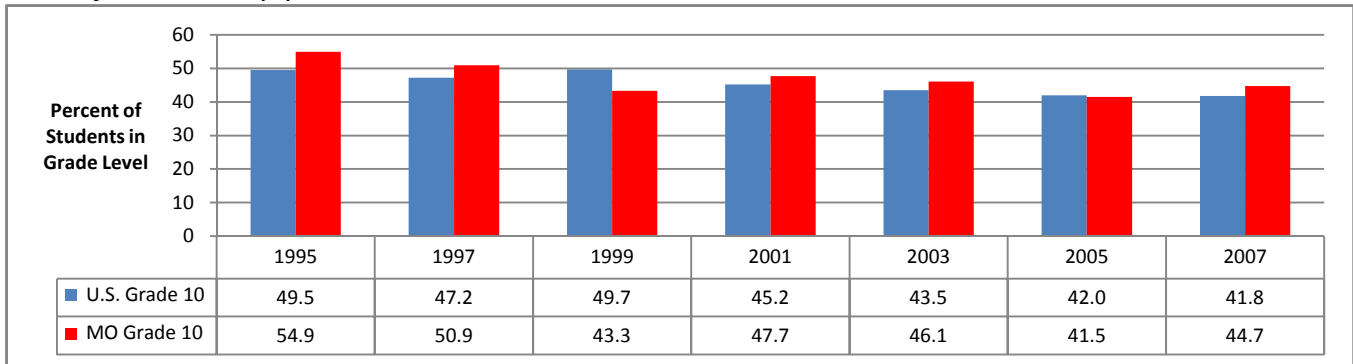

Past 30-Day Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 9, 1995-2007



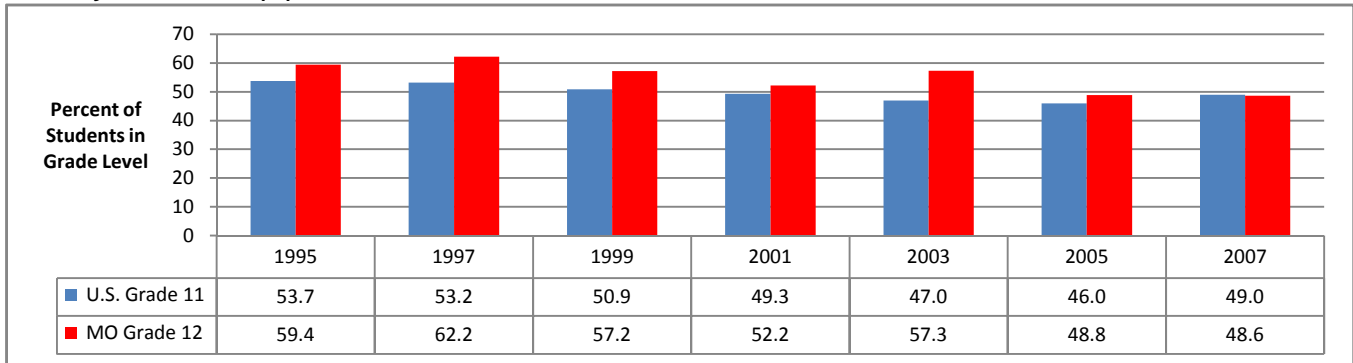

Past 30-Day Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 10, 1995-2007



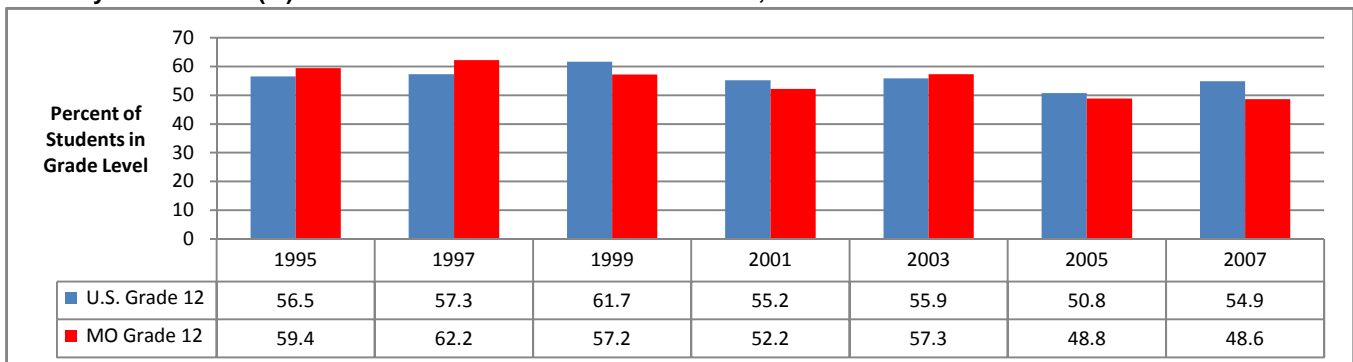

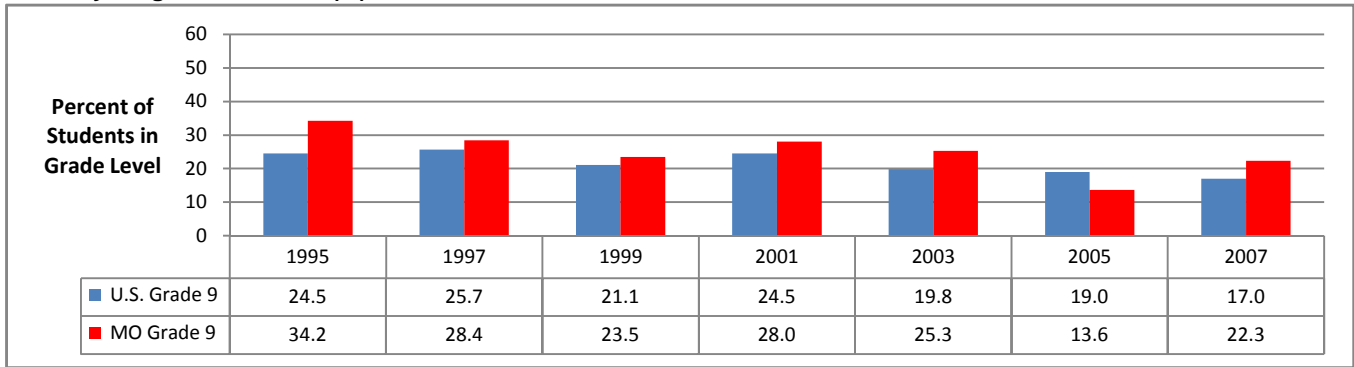
Past 30-Day Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 12, 1995-2007

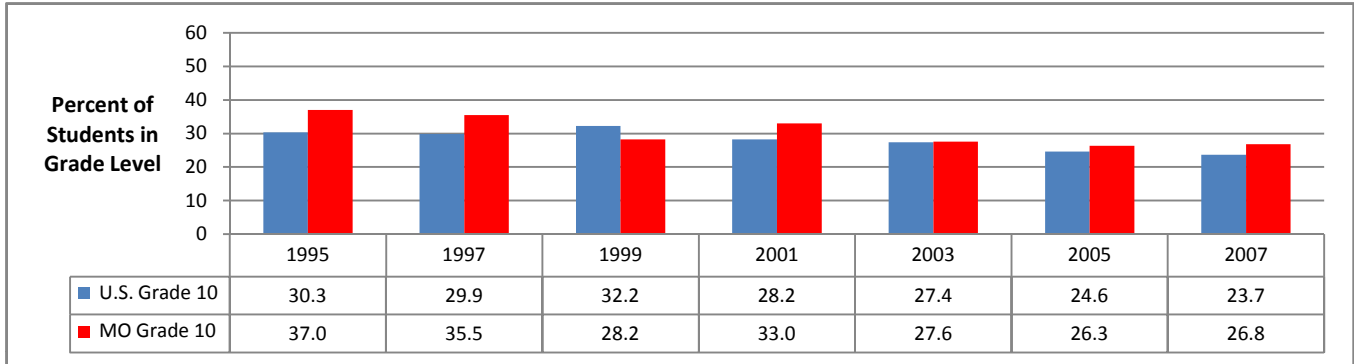

Past 30-Day Binge Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 9, 1995-2007



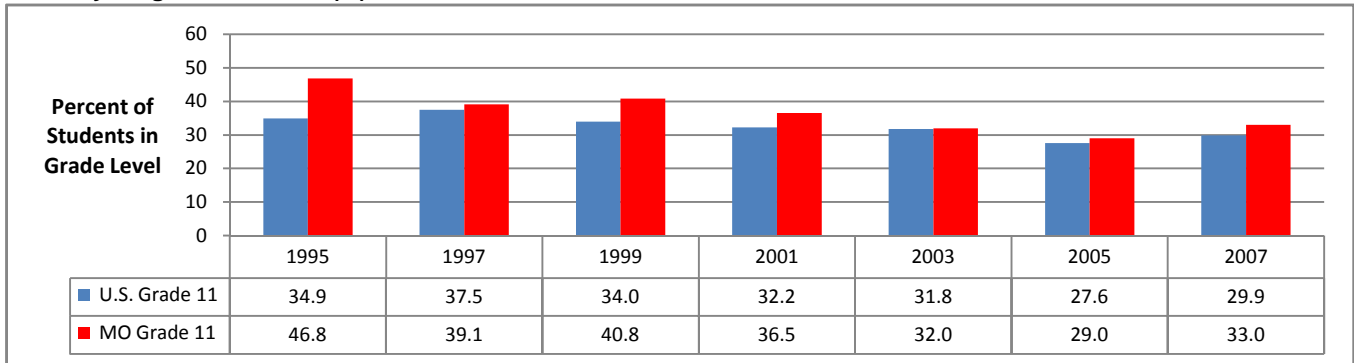

Past 30-Day Binge Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 10, 1995-2007



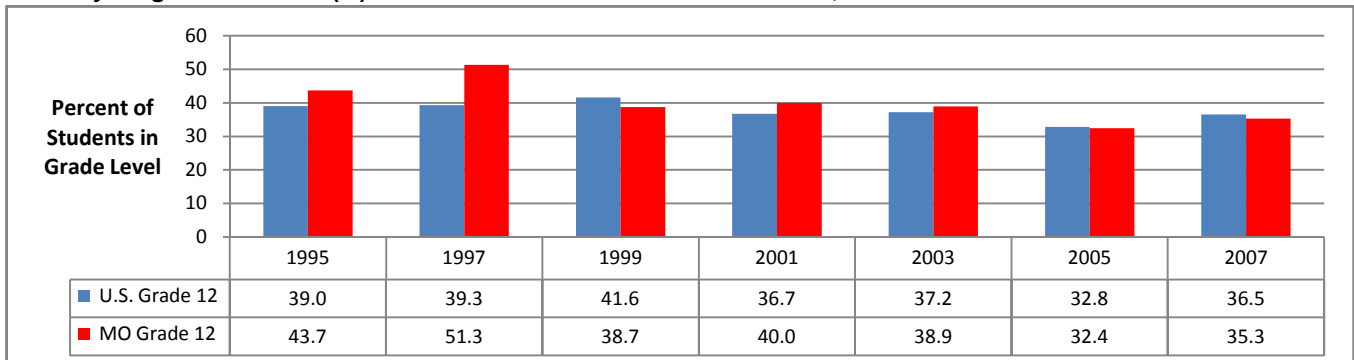

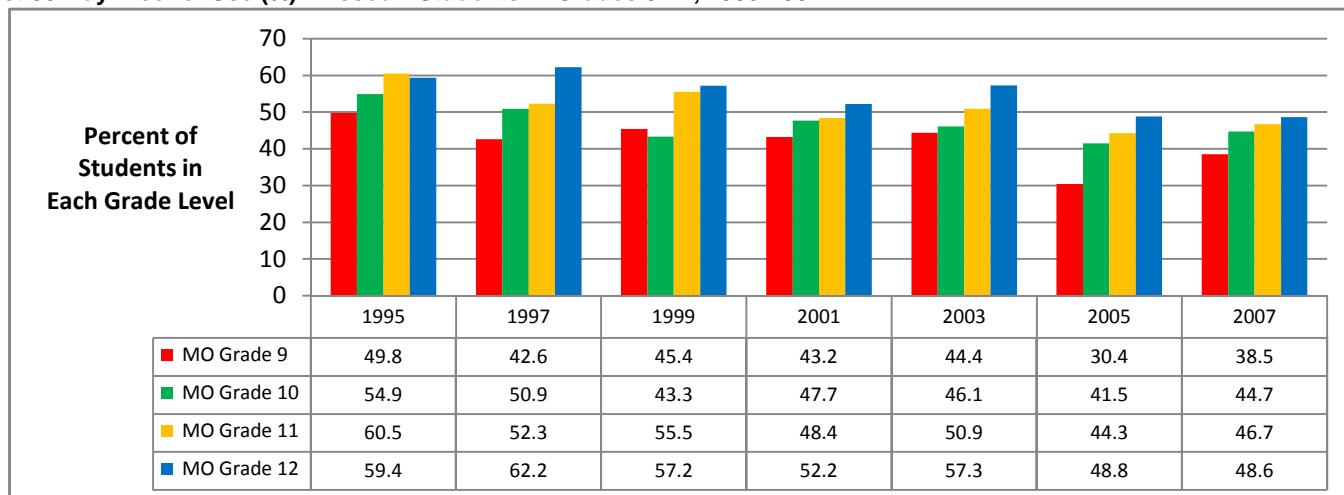
Past 30-Day Binge Alcohol Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 12, 1995-2007

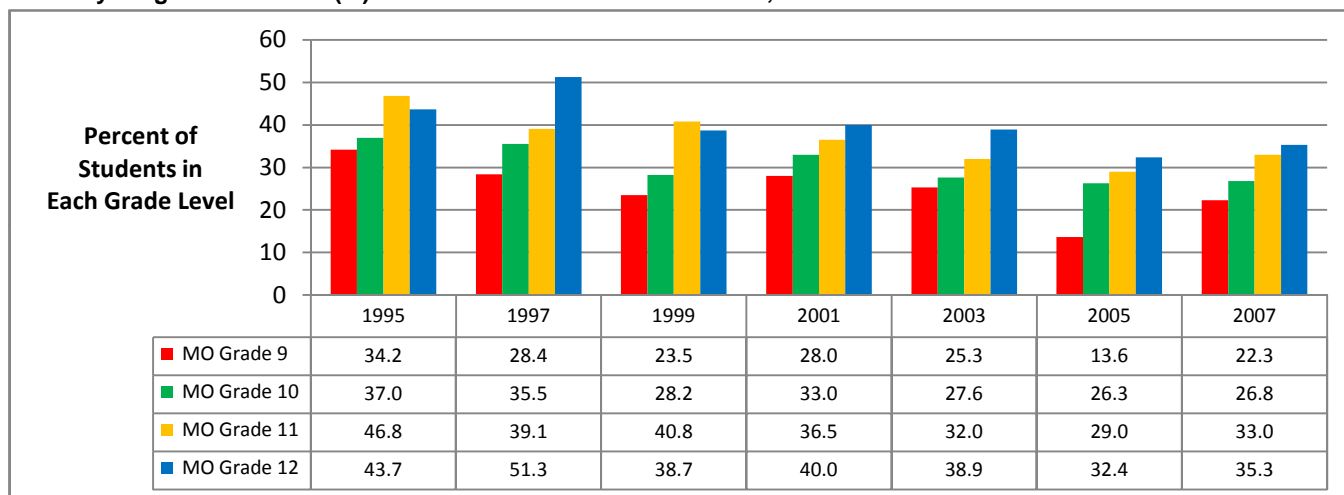

Past 30-Day Alcohol Use (%): Missouri Students in Grades 9-12, 1995-2007



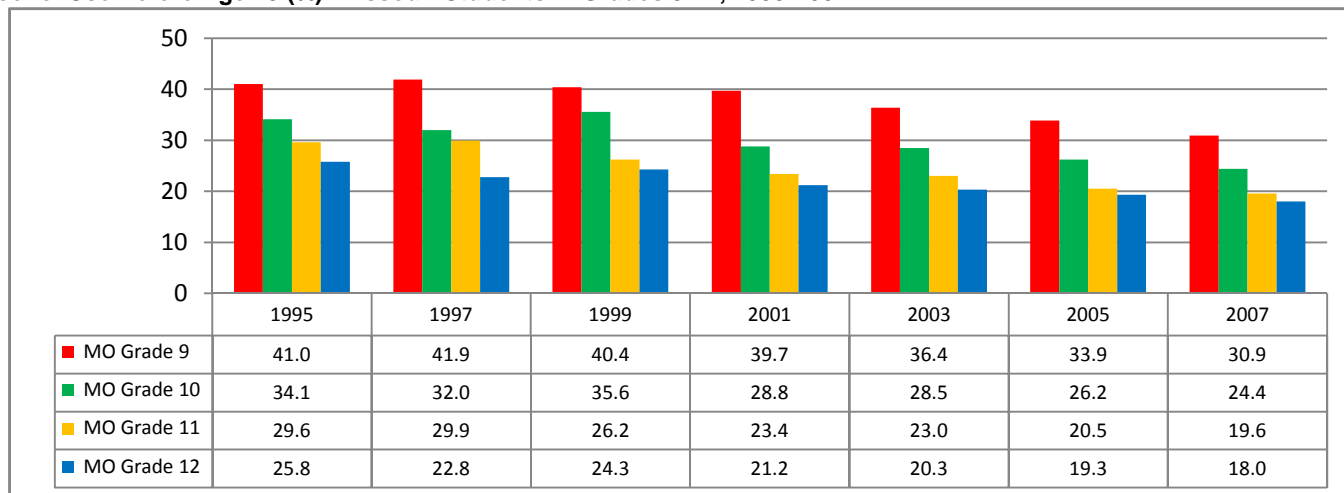

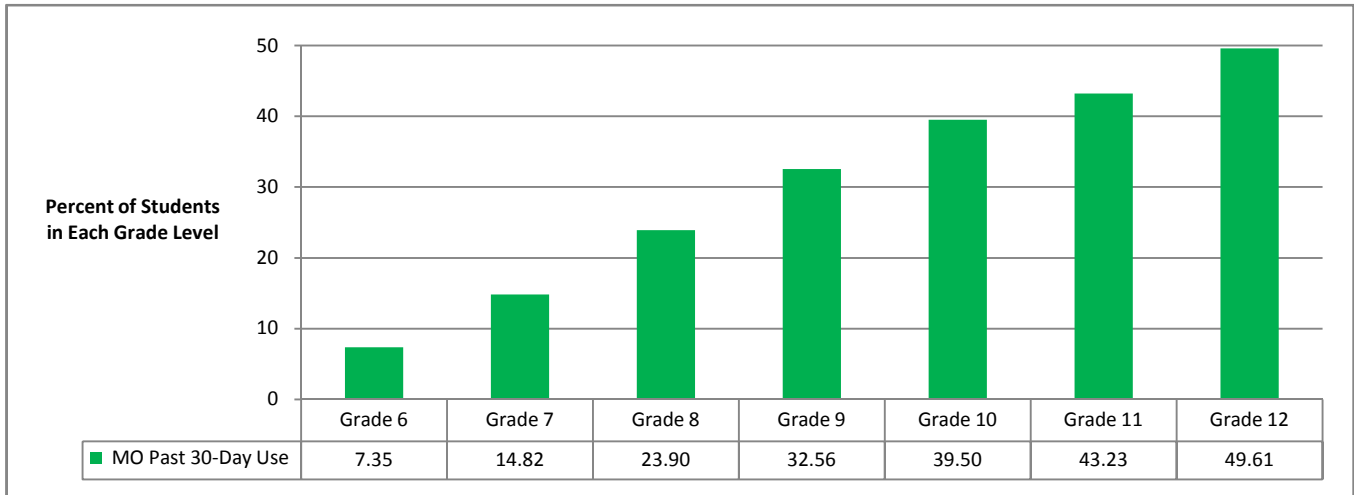
Alcohol Use Before Age 13 (%): Missouri Students in Grades 9-12, 1995-2007

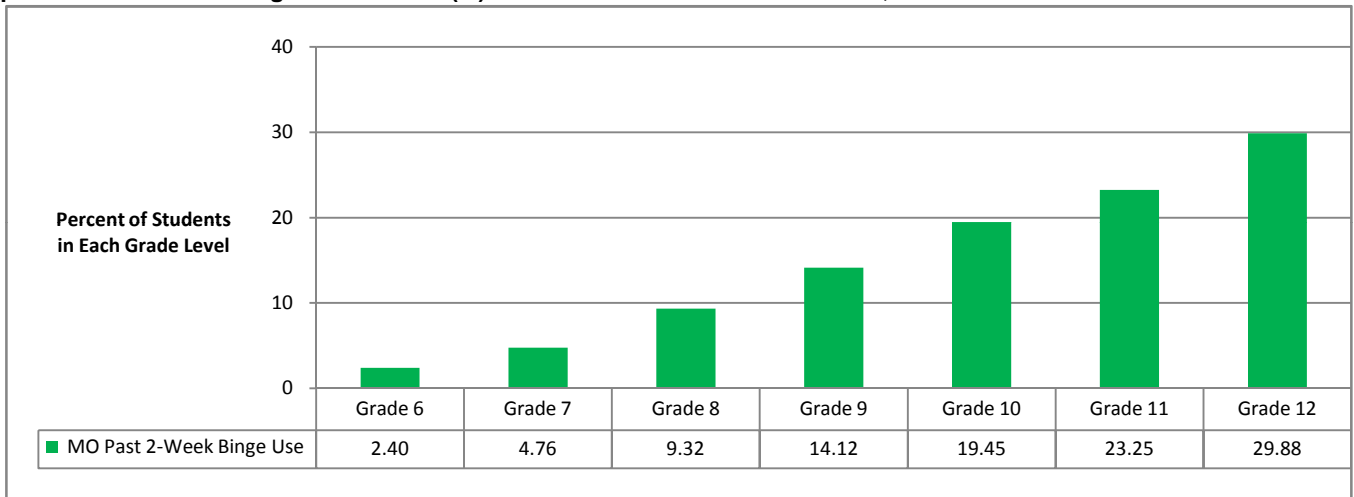

Reported Past 30-Day Alcohol Use (%): Missouri Students in Grades 6-12, 2006



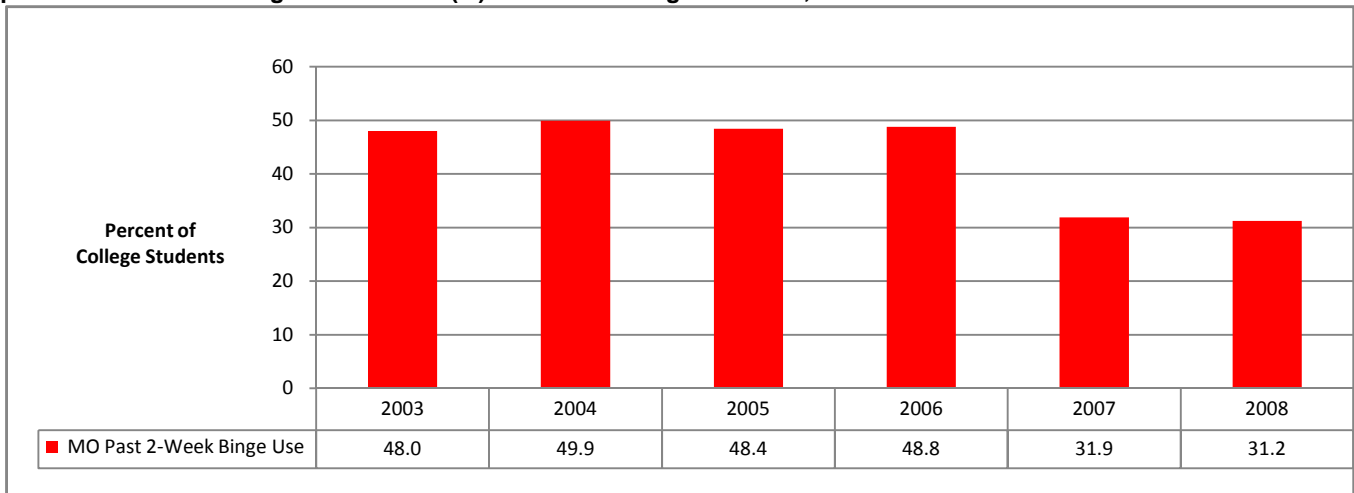

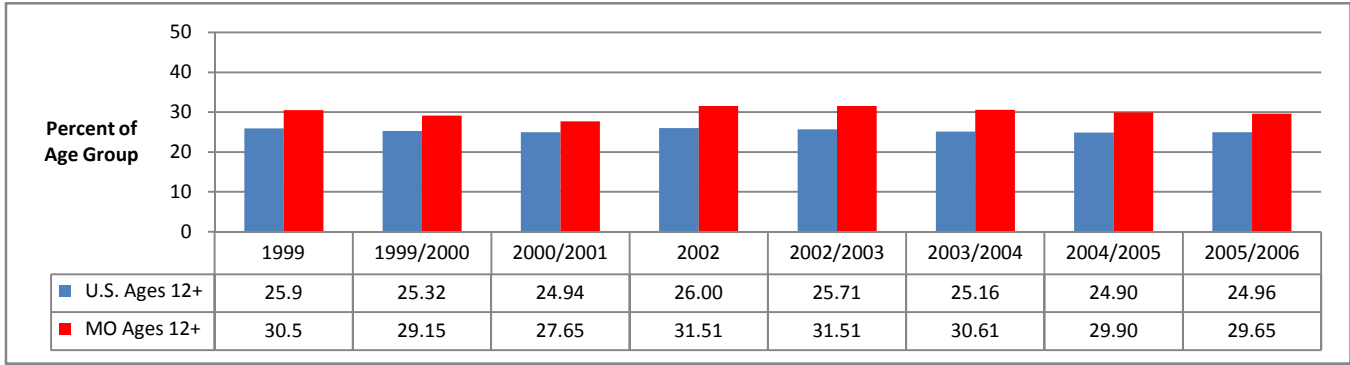

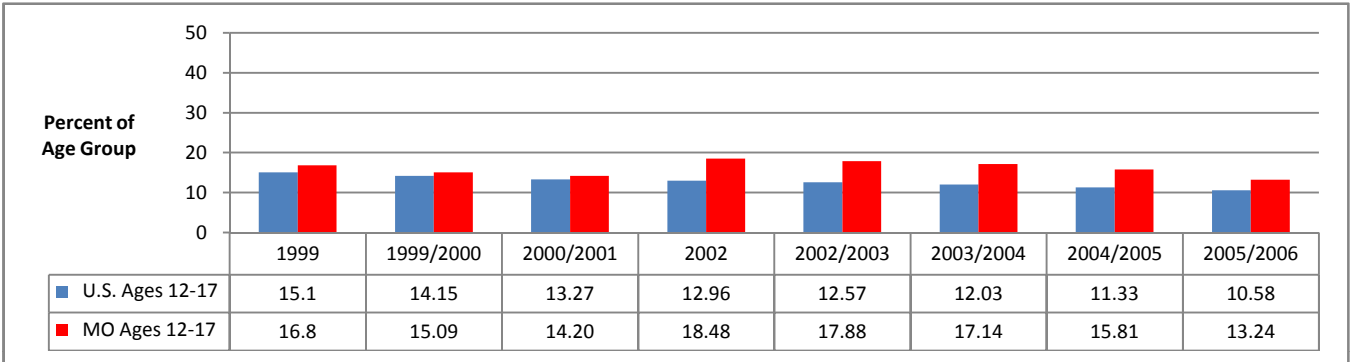

Estimated Past-Month Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



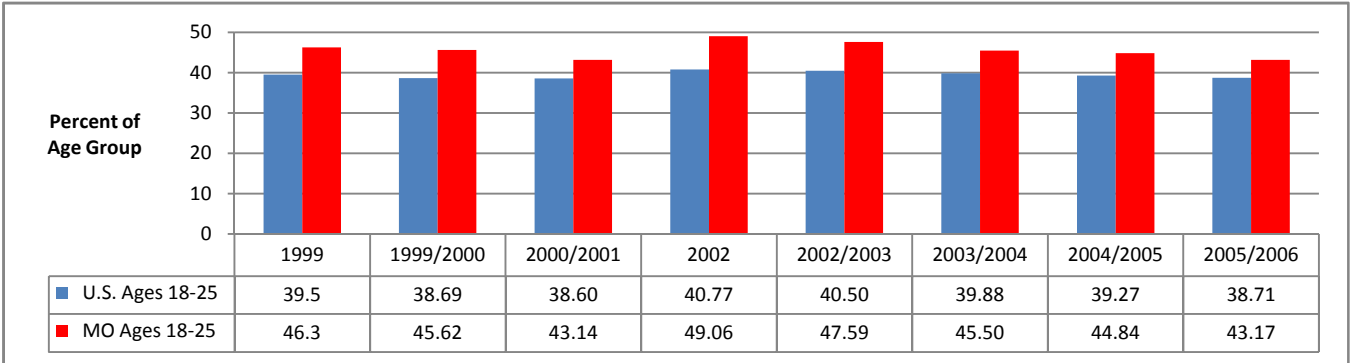

Estimated Past-Month Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



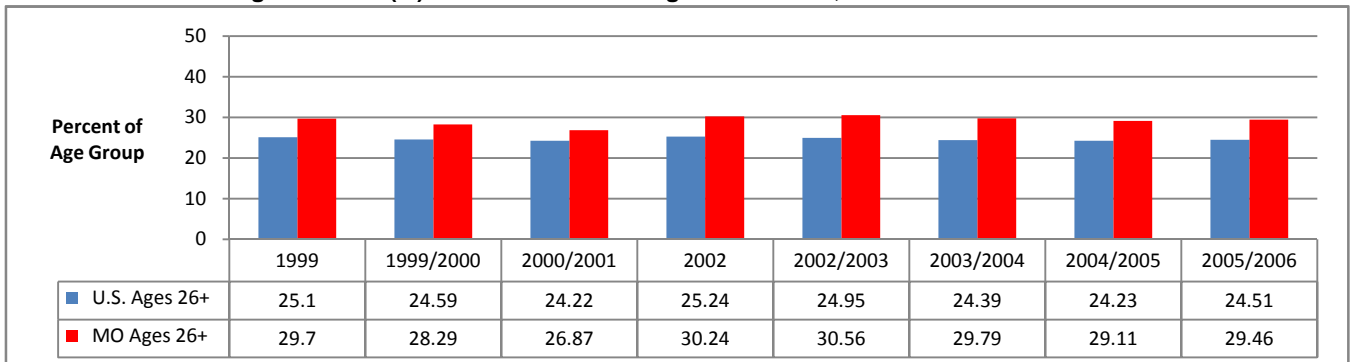

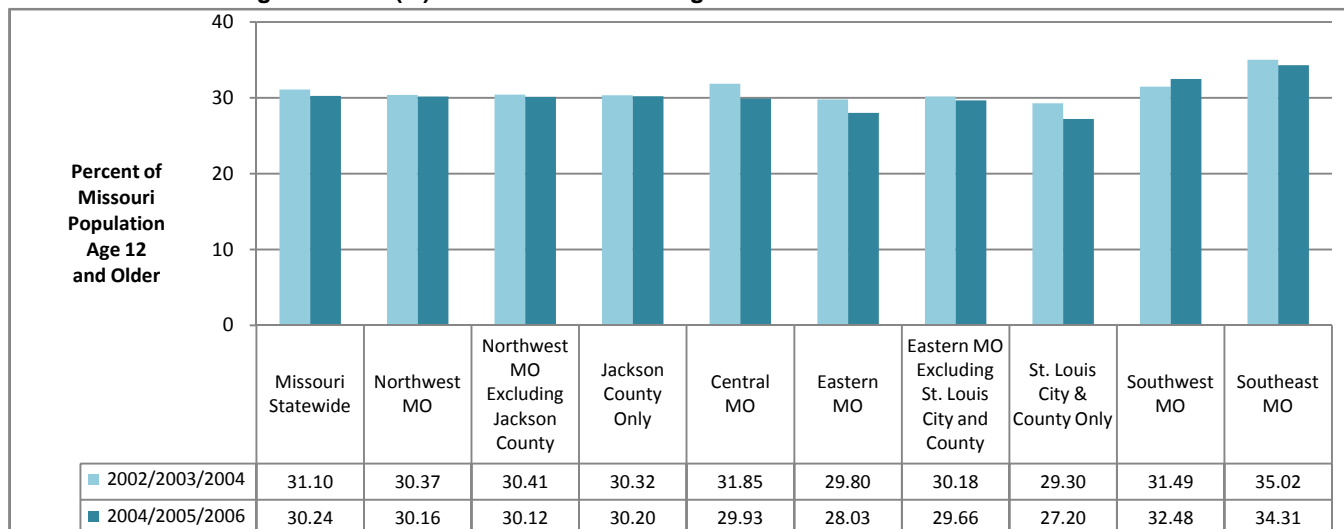
Estimated Past-Month Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

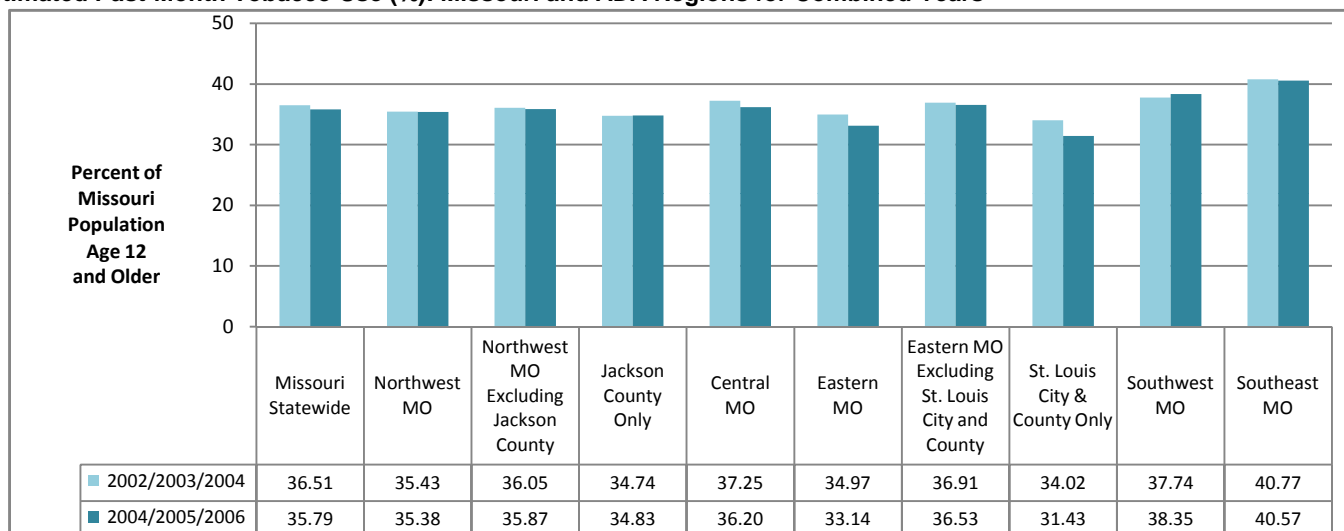

Estimated Past-Month Cigarette Use (%): Missouri and ADA Regions for Combined Years



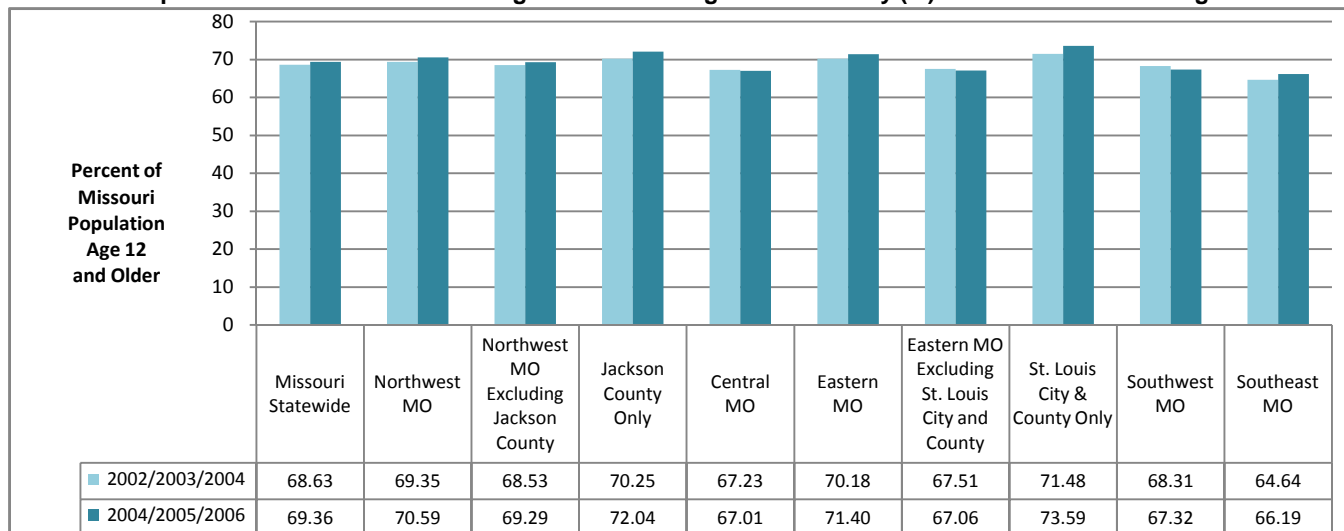

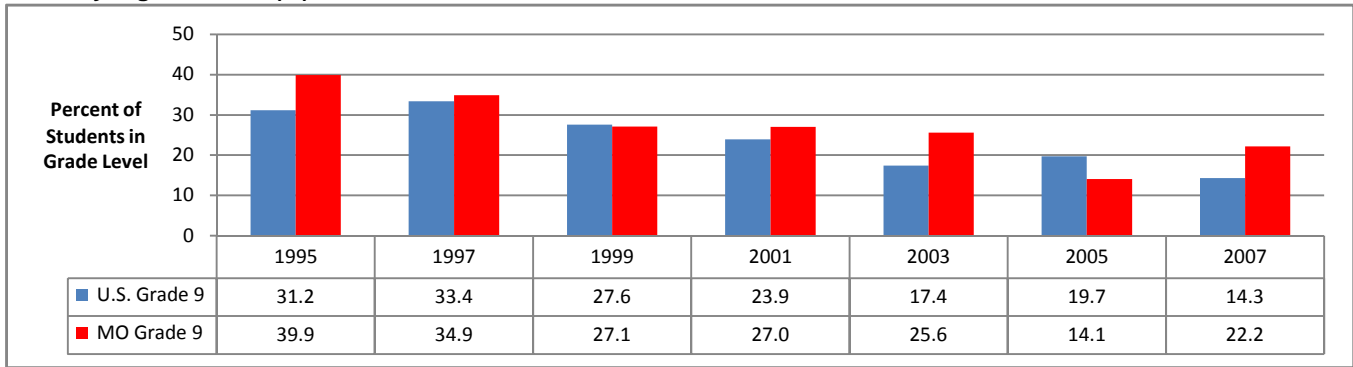
Estimated Perceptions of Great Risk of Smoking One Pack of Cigarettes Per Day (%): Missouri and ADA Regions

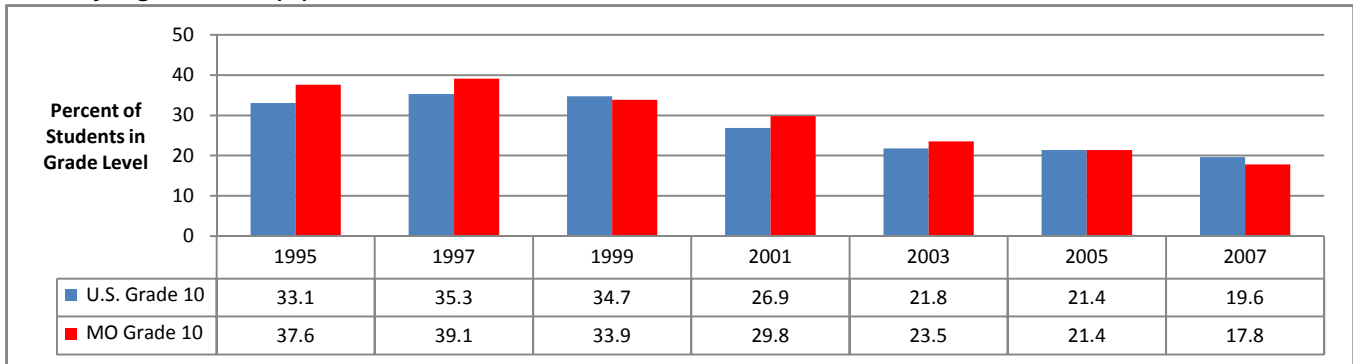

Past 30-Day Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 9, 1995-2007



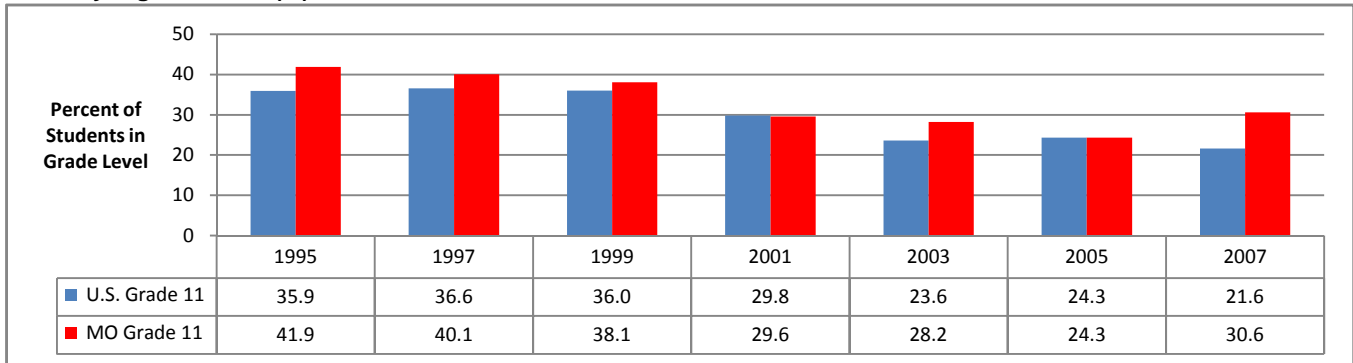

Past 30-Day Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 10, 1995-2007



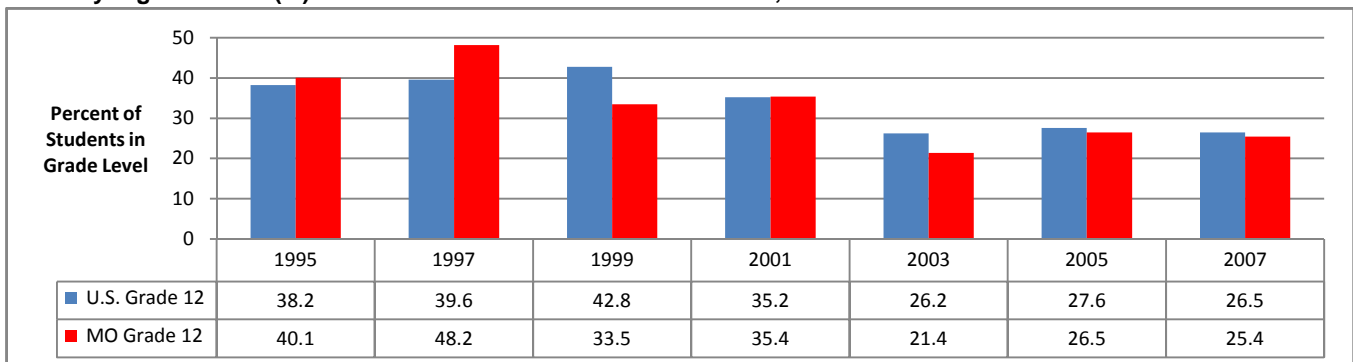

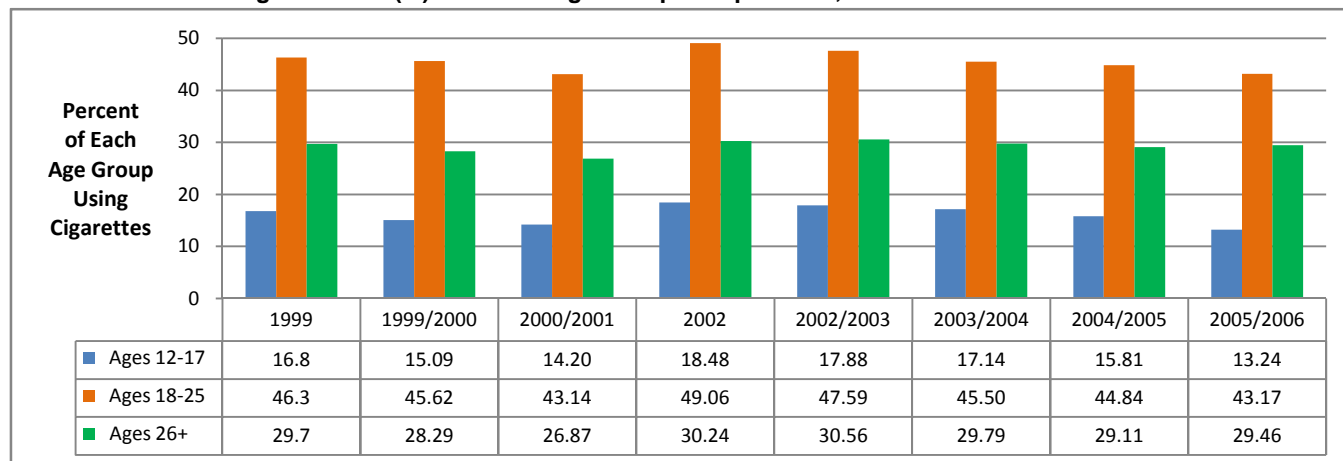
Past 30-Day Cigarette Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 12, 1995-2007

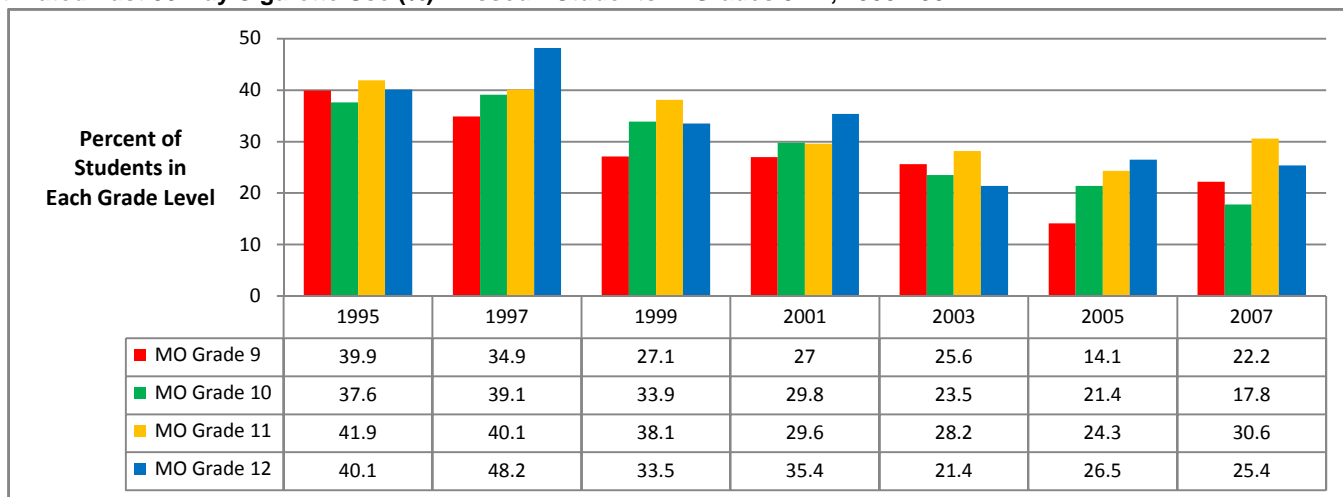

Estimated Past-Month Cigarette Use (%): Missouri Age Group Comparisons, 1999-2006



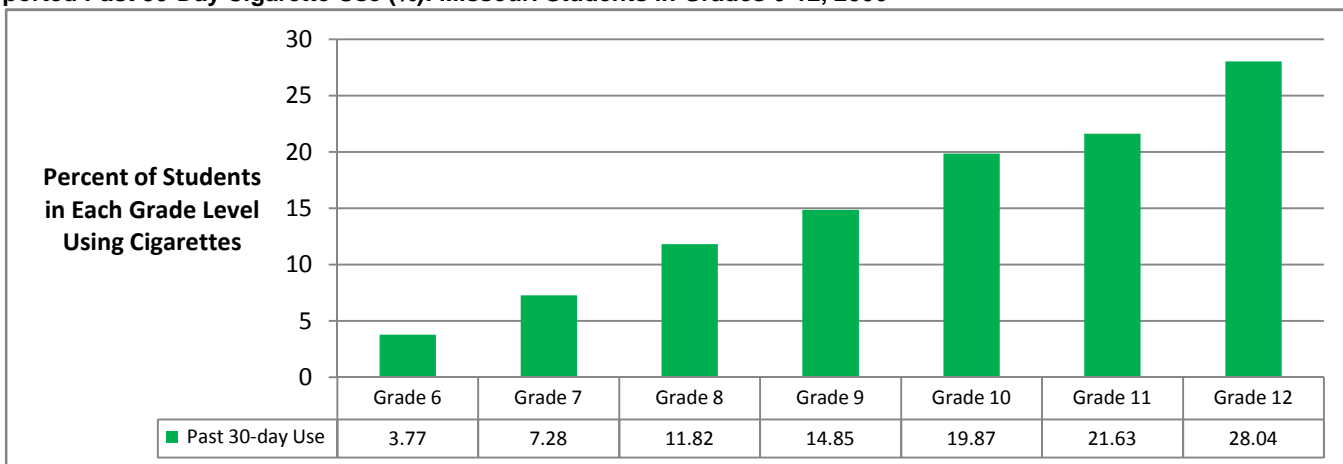

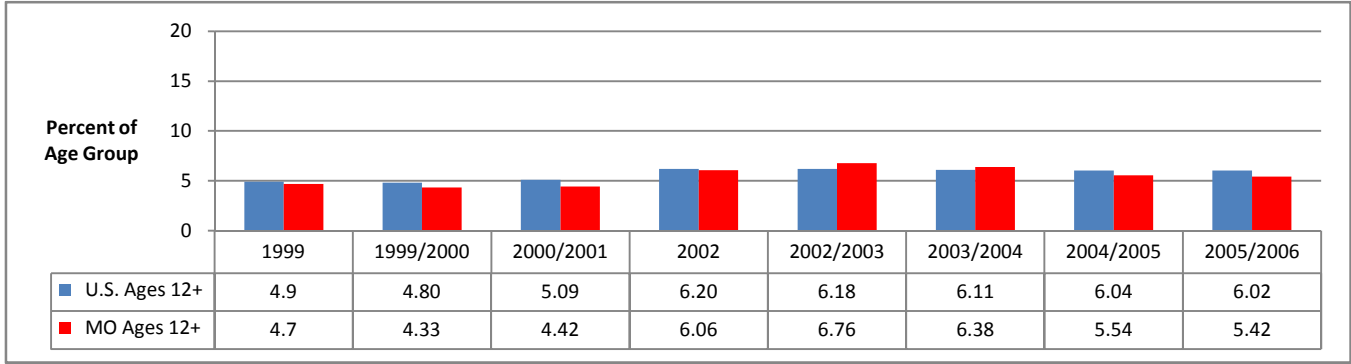
Reported Past 30-Day Cigarette Use (%): Missouri Students in Grades 6-12, 2006

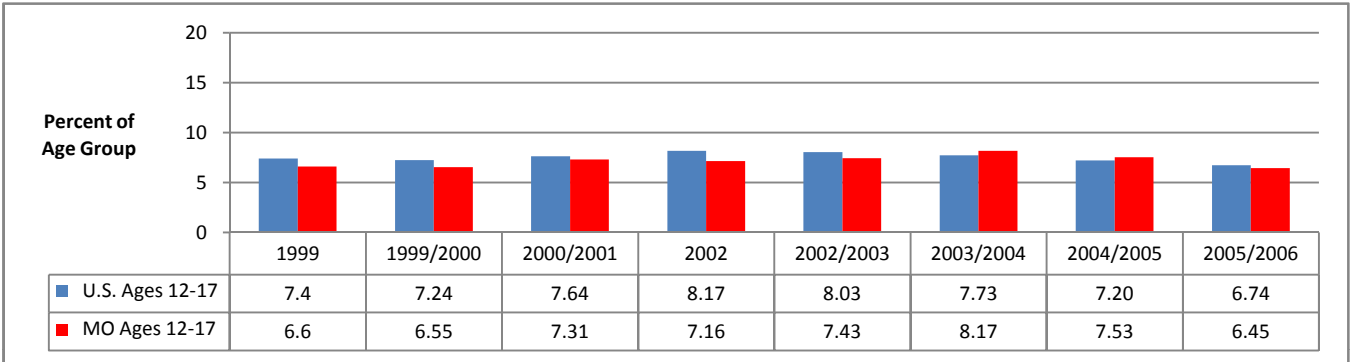

Estimated Past-Month Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



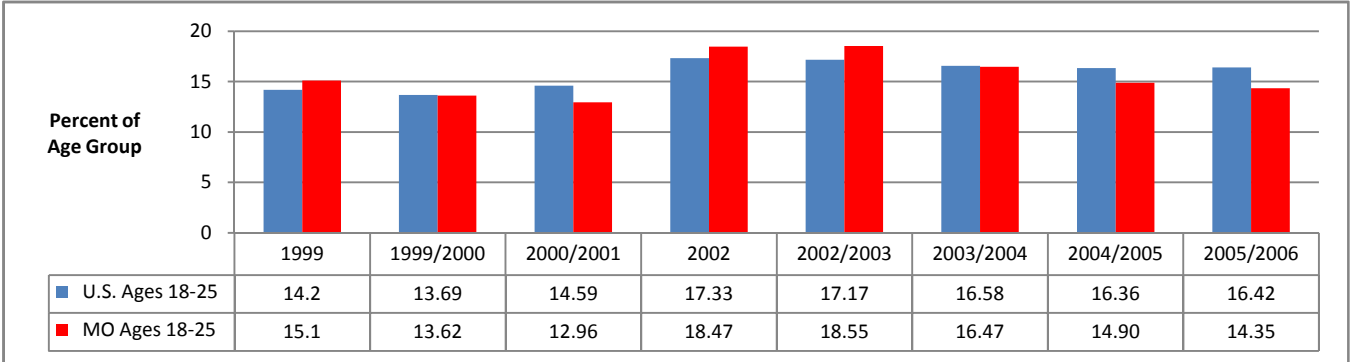

Estimated Past-Month Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



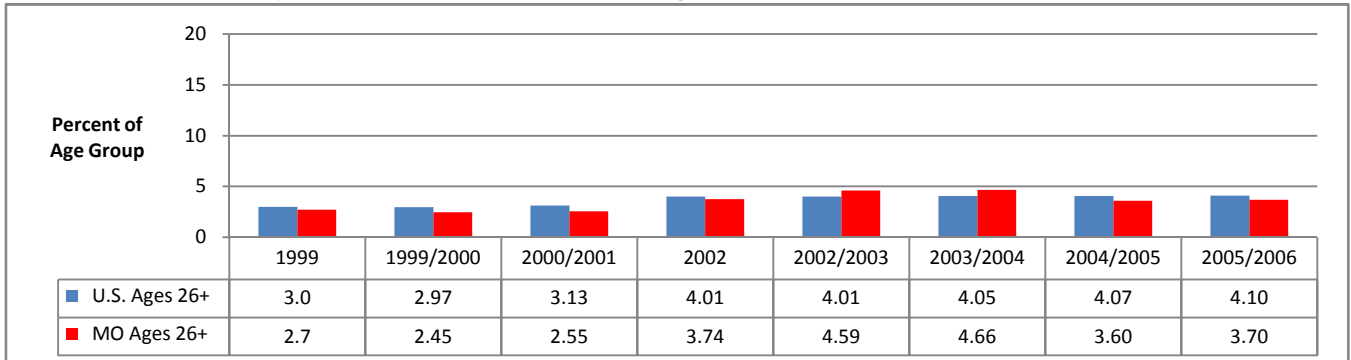

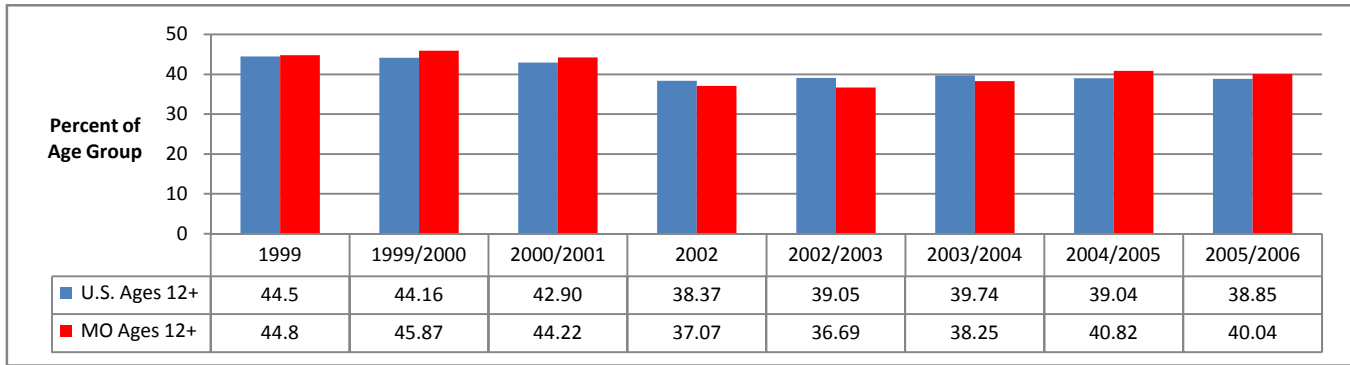
Estimated Past-Month Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

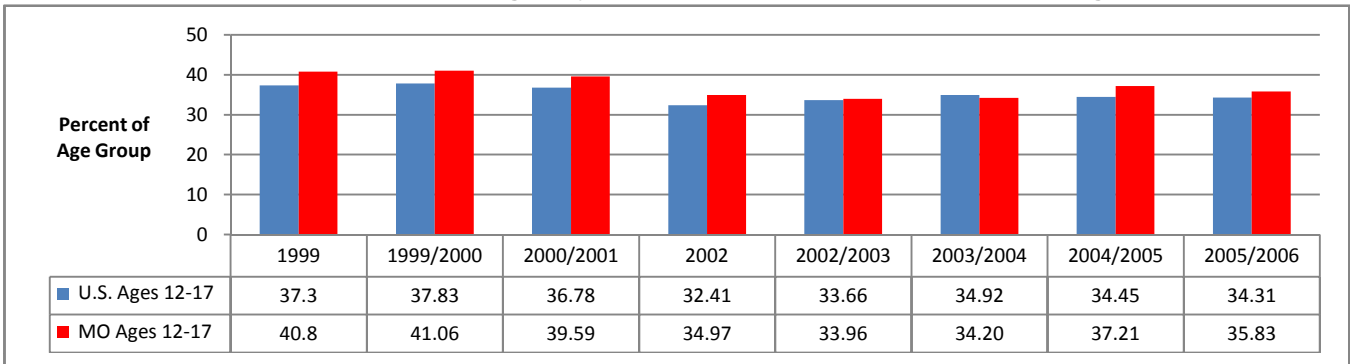

Estimated Perceptions of Great Risk of Smoking Marijuana Once a Month (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



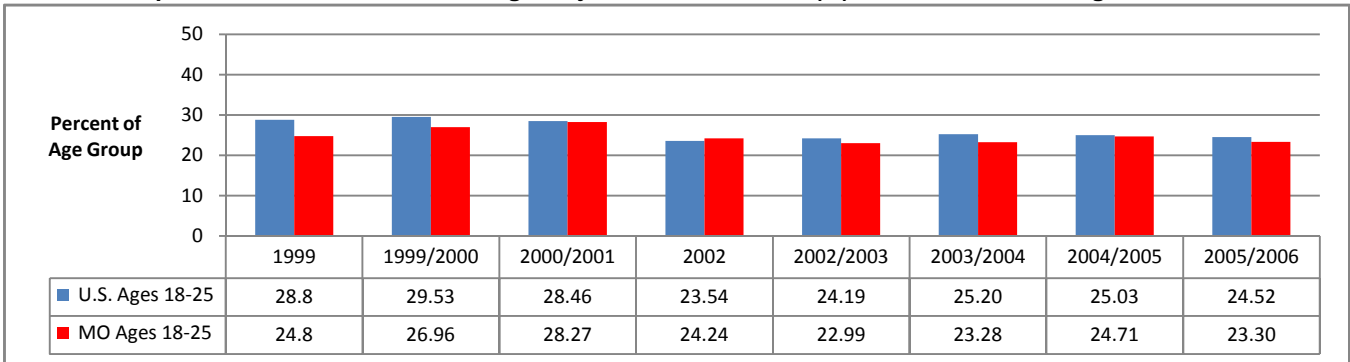

Estimated Perceptions of Great Risk of Smoking Marijuana Once a Month (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



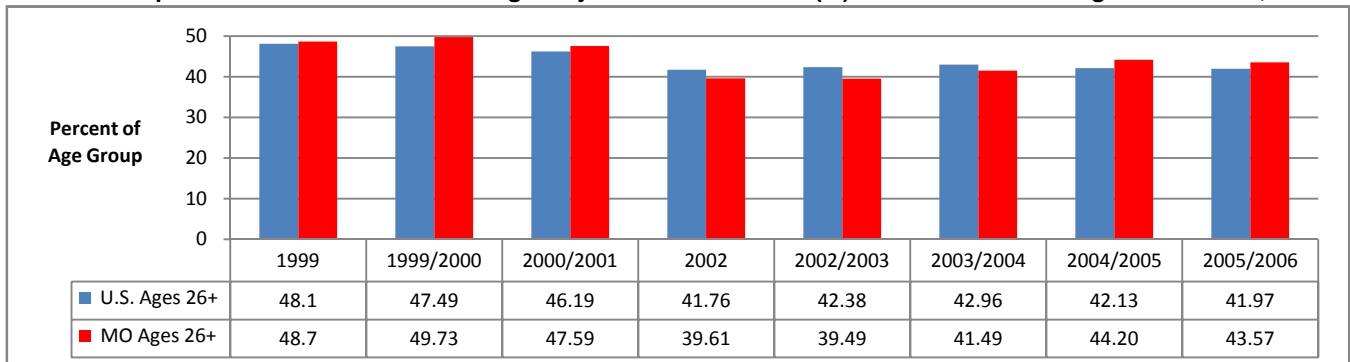

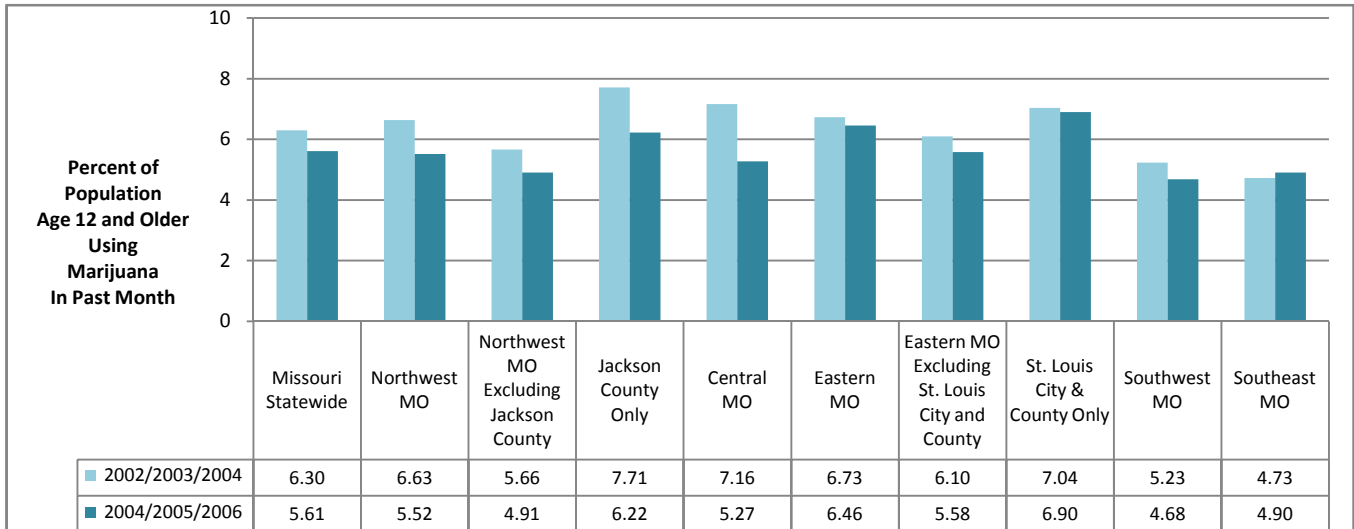
Estimated Perceptions of Great Risk of Smoking Marijuana Once a Month (%): U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 1999-2006

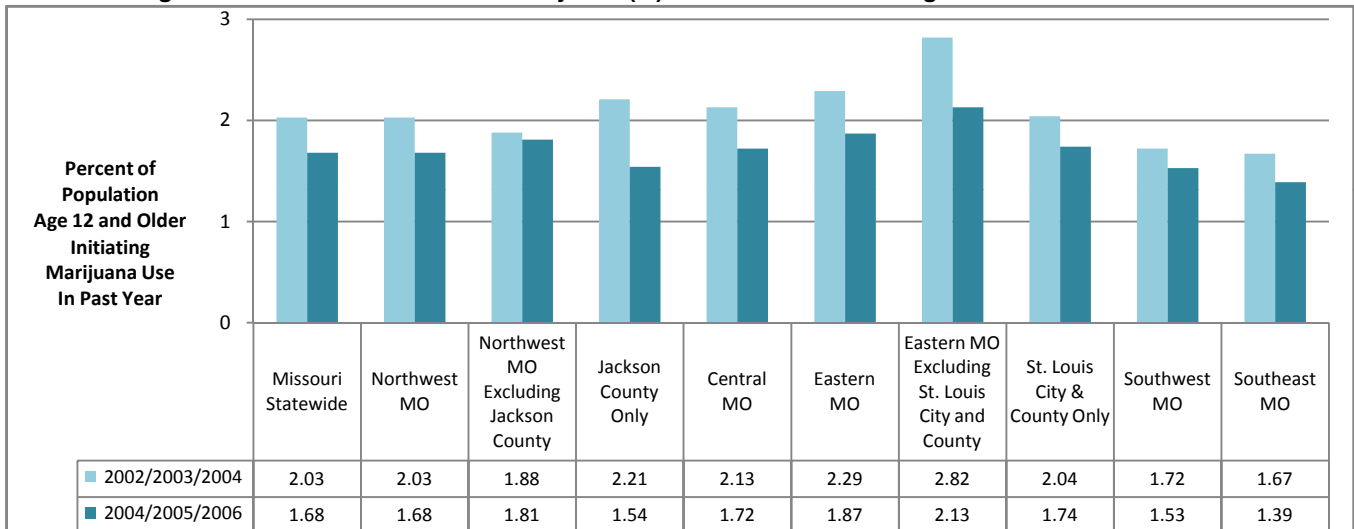

Estimated Past-Month Marijuana Use (%): Missouri and ADA Regions for Combined Years



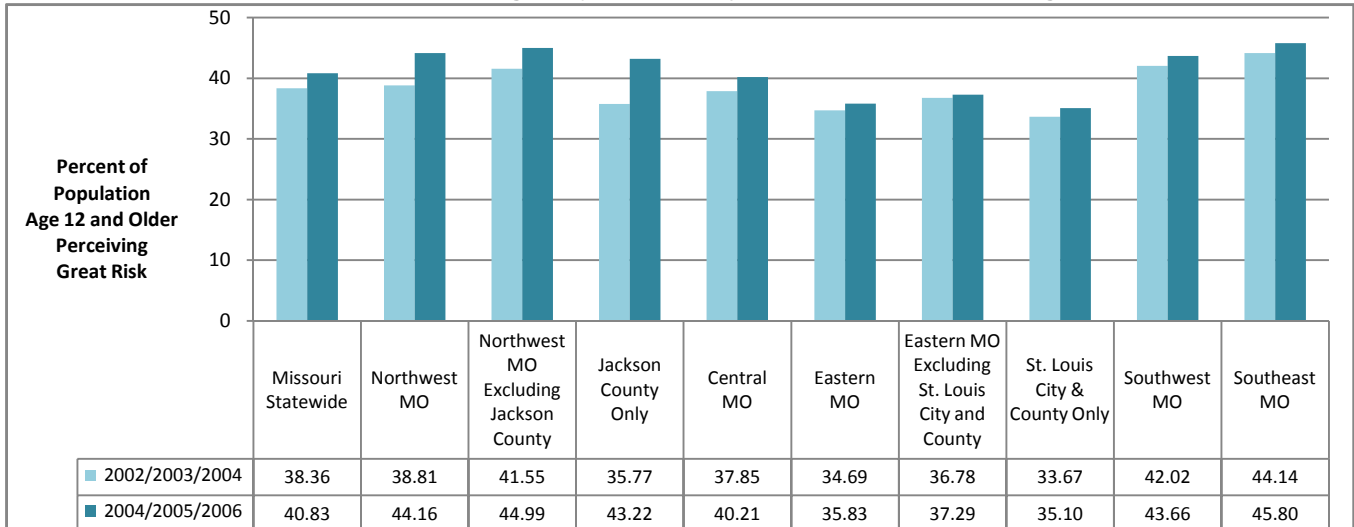

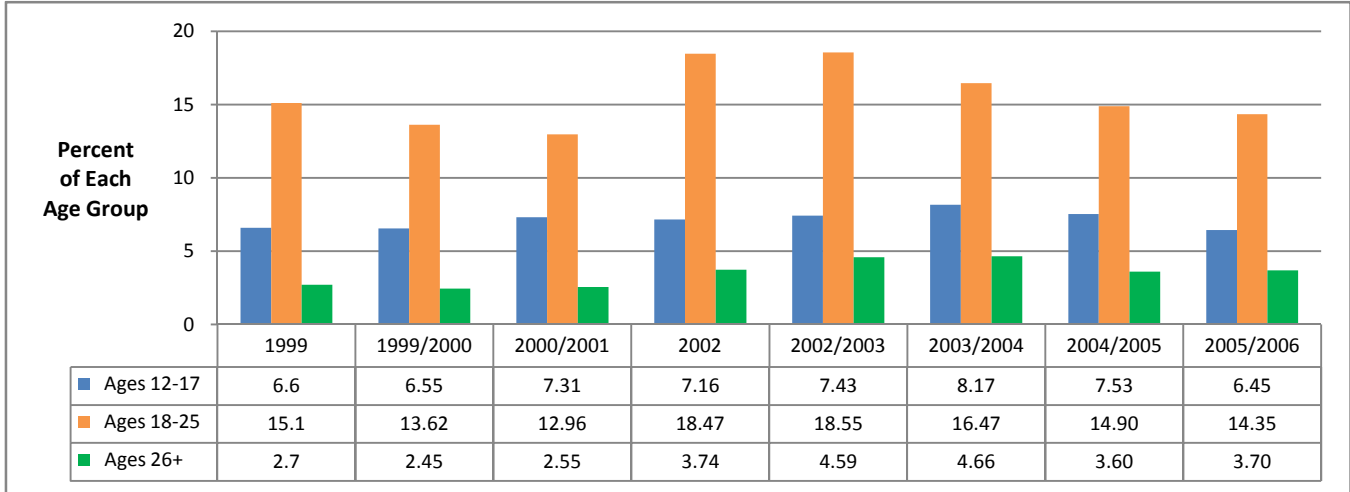
Estimated Perceptions of Great Risk of Smoking Marijuana Monthly (%): Missouri and ADA Regions for Combined Years

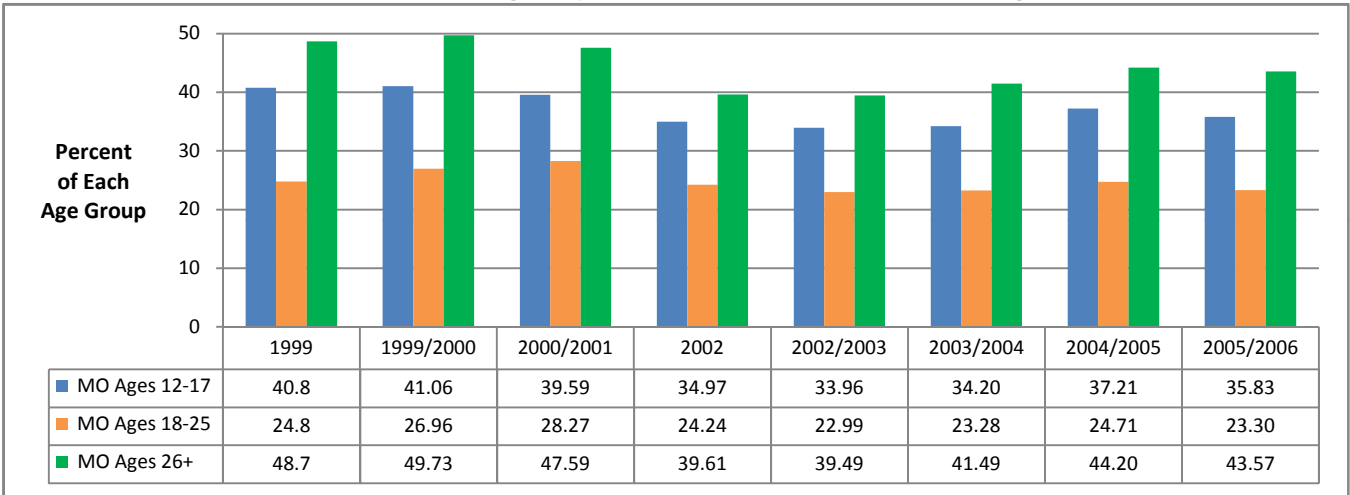

Estimated Past-Month Marijuana Use (%): Missouri Age Groups, 1999-2006



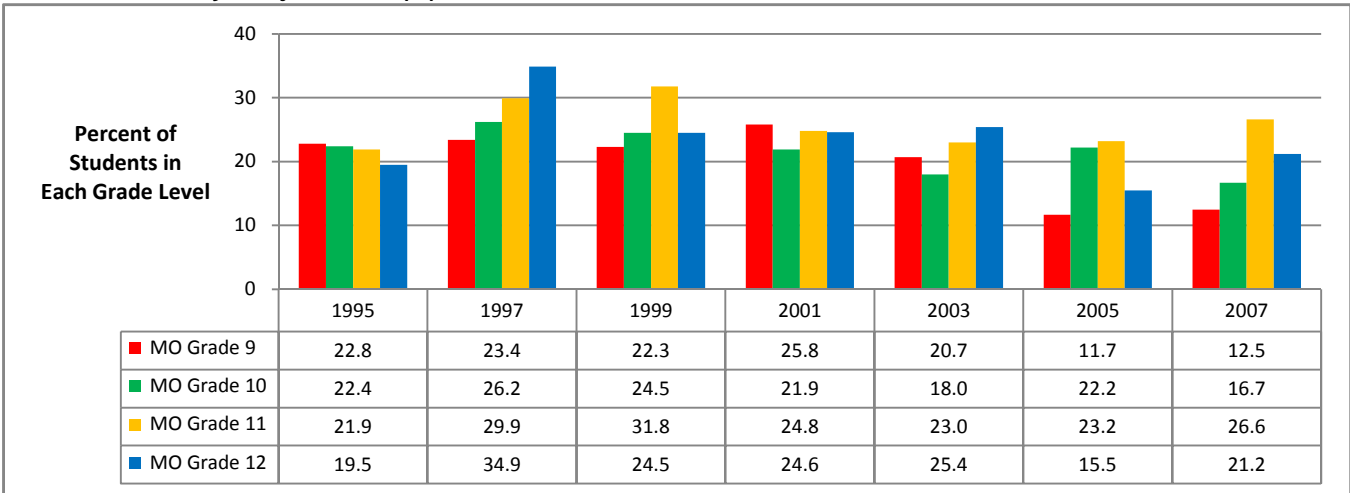

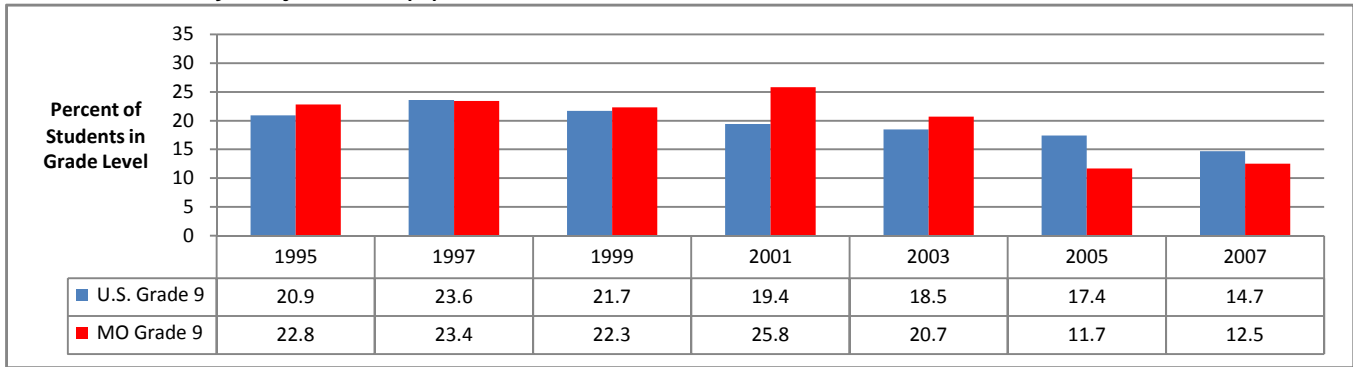
Estimated Past 30-Day Marijuana Use (%): Missouri Students in Grades 9-12, 1995-2007

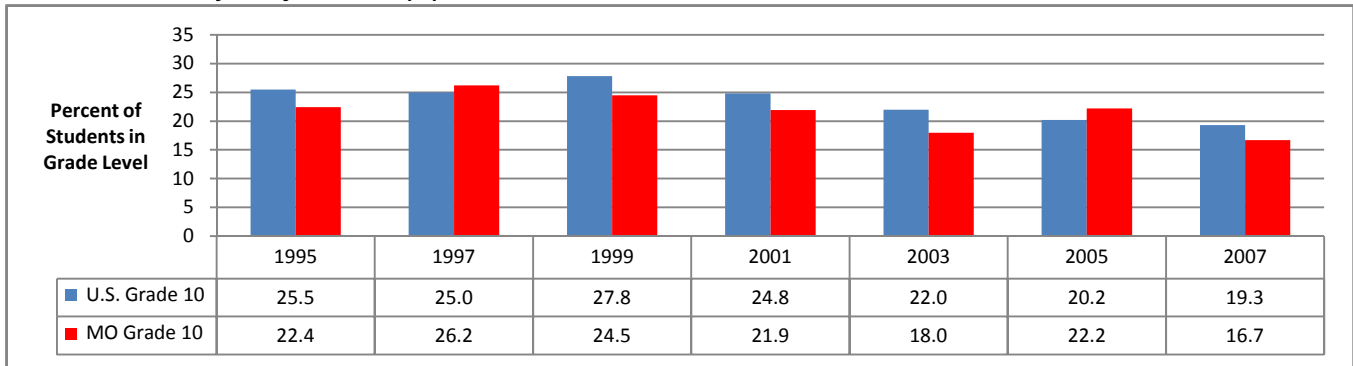

Estimated Past 30-Day Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 9, 1995-2007



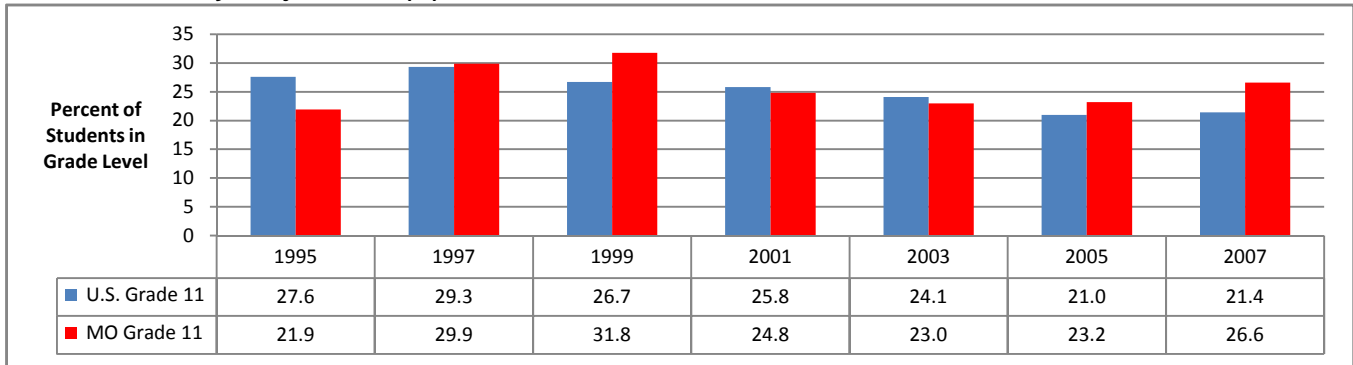

Estimated Past 30-Day Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 10, 1995-2007



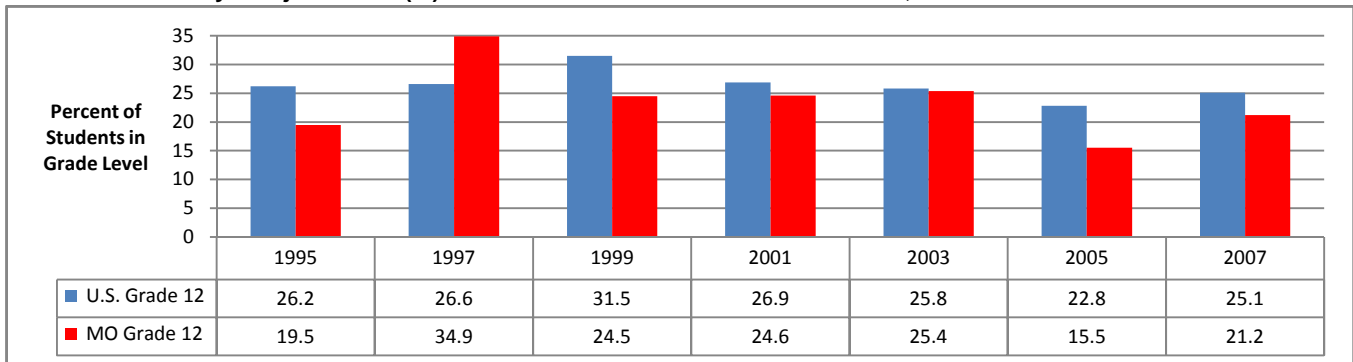

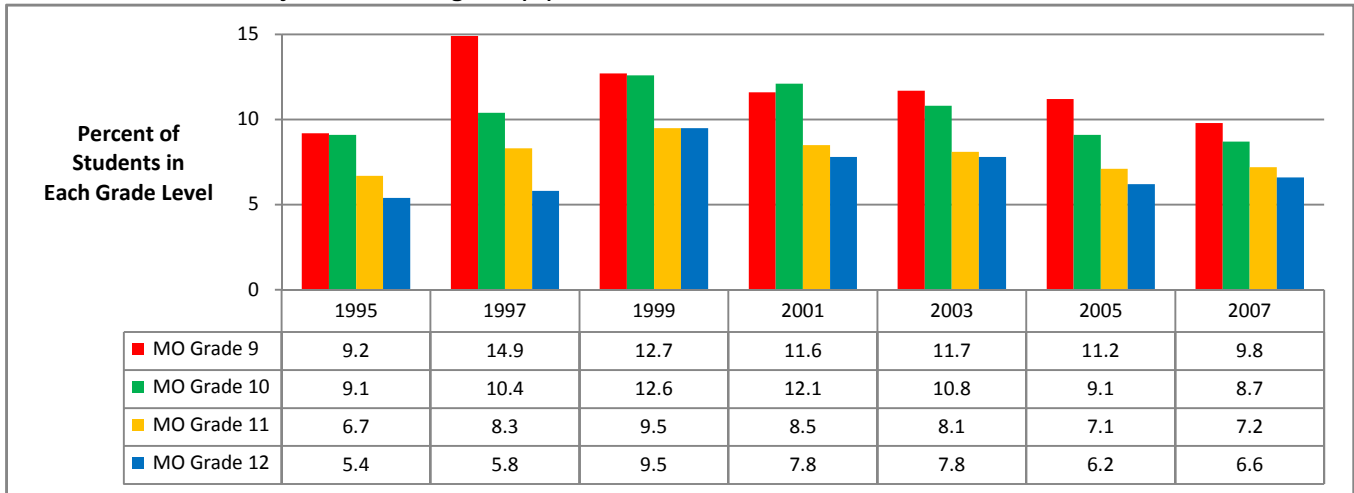
Estimated Past 30-Day Marijuana Use (%): U.S. and Missouri Students in Grade 12, 1995-2007

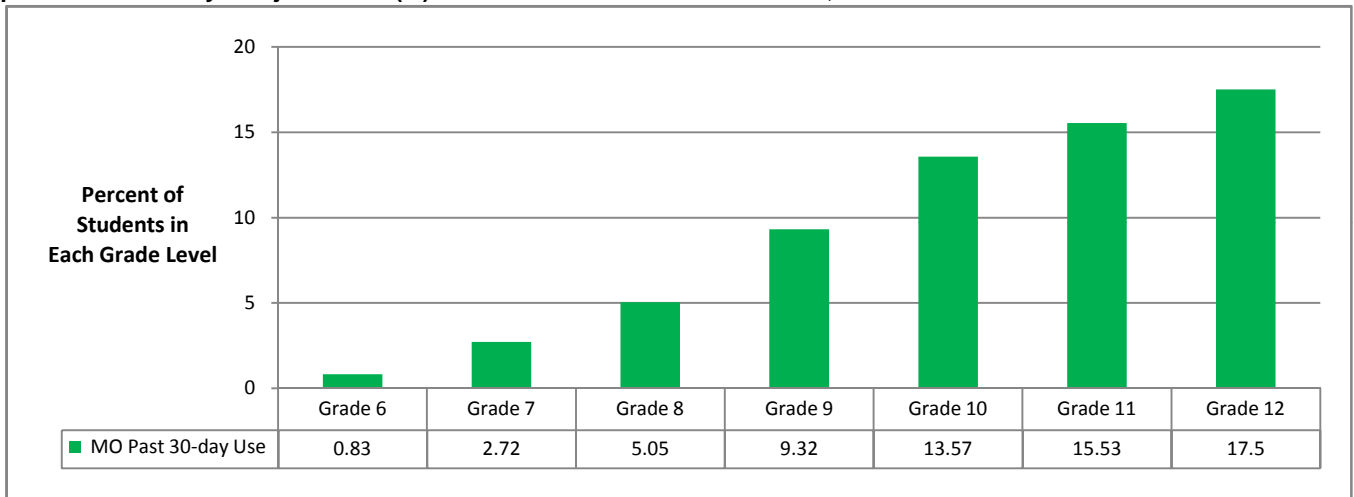

Estimated First Use of Marijuana Before Age 13 (%): Missouri Students in Grades 9-12, 1995-2007



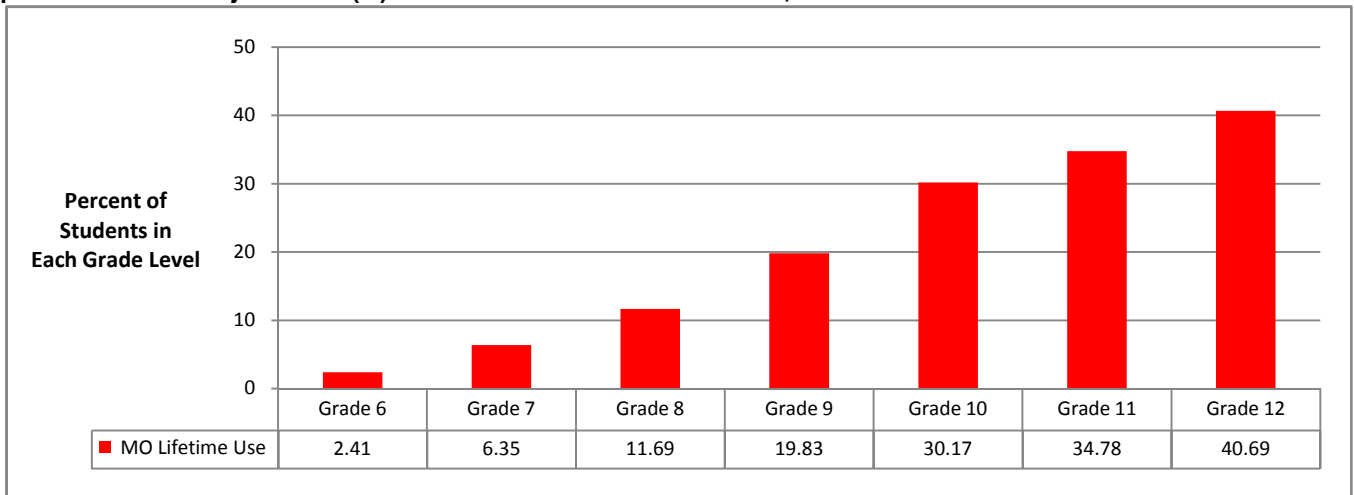

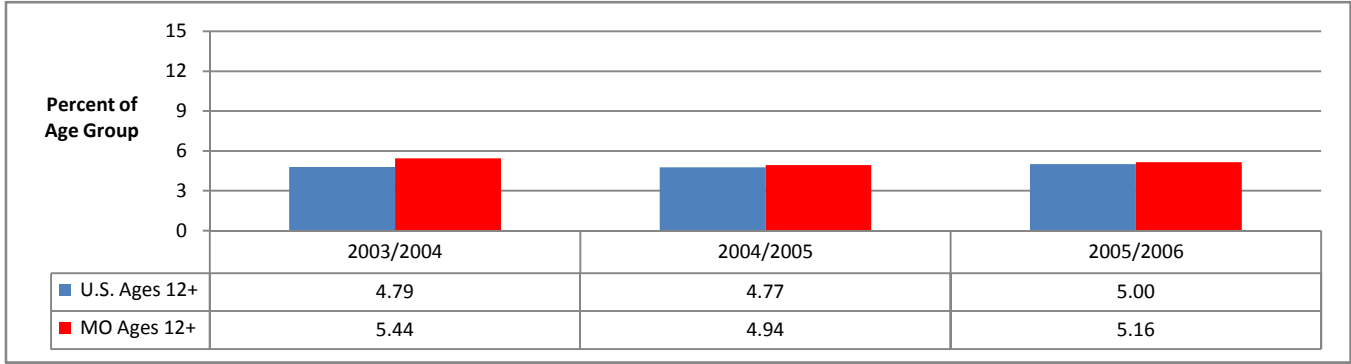
Reported Lifetime Marijuana Use (%): Missouri Students in Grades 6-12, 2006

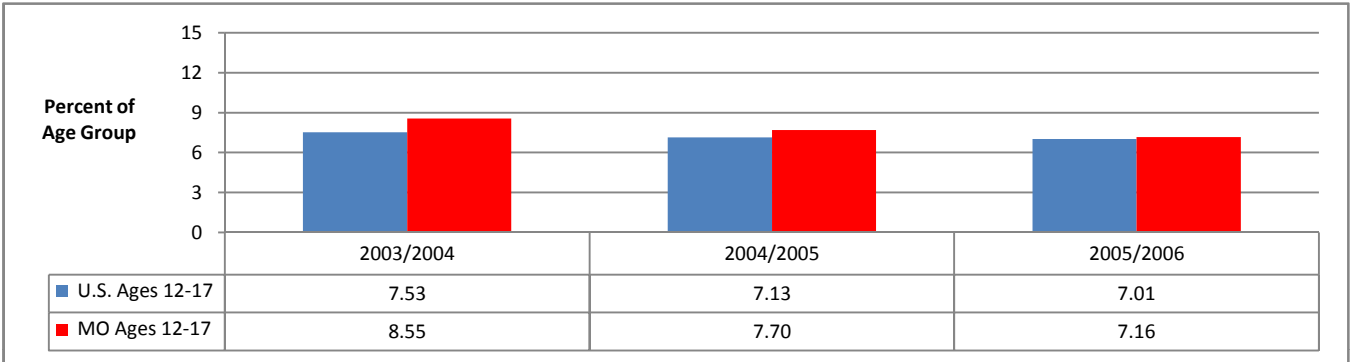

Estimated Past-Year Use of Pain Relievers: U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 2004-2006



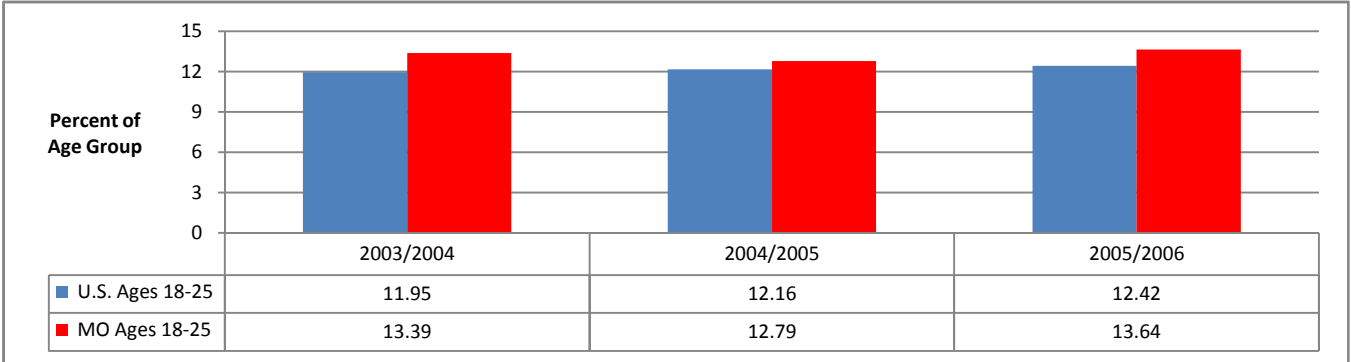

Estimated Past-Year Use of Pain Relievers: U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 2004-2006



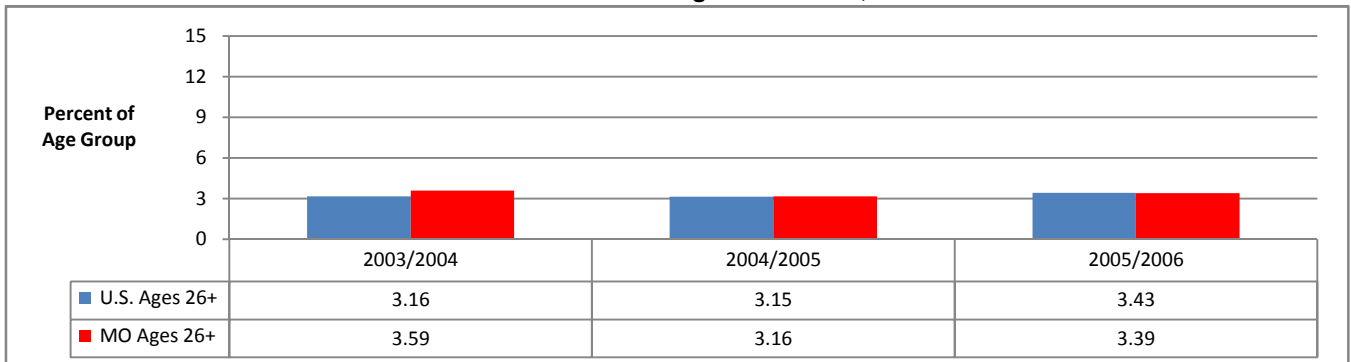

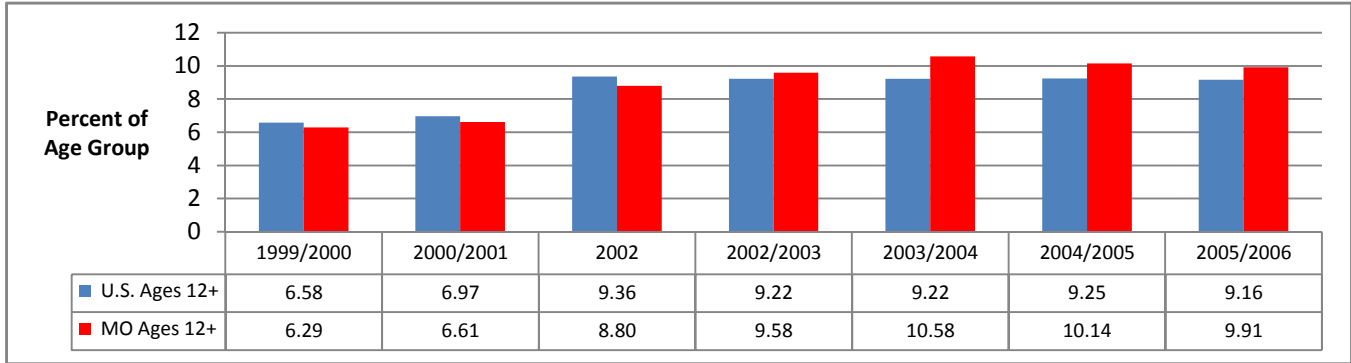
Estimated Past-Year Use of Pain Relievers: U.S. and Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 2004-2006

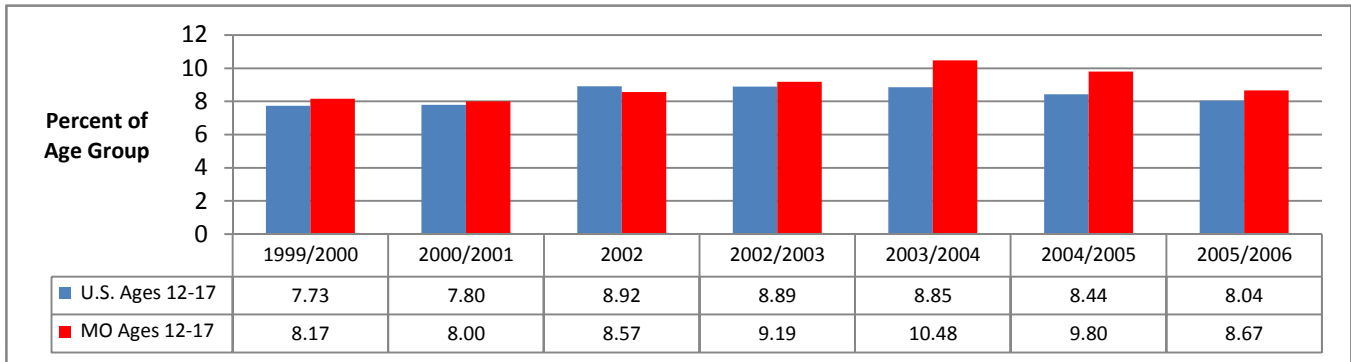

Estimated Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse, U.S. and Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



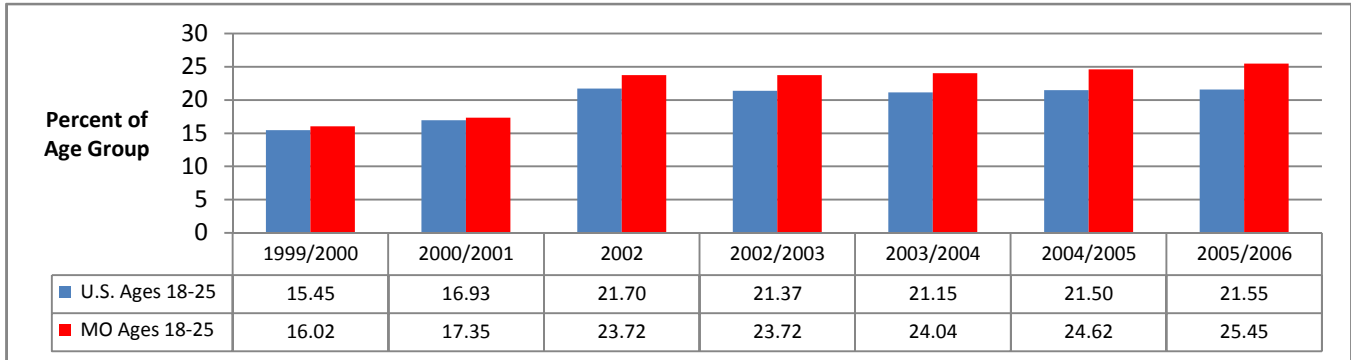

Estimated Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse: U.S. and Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



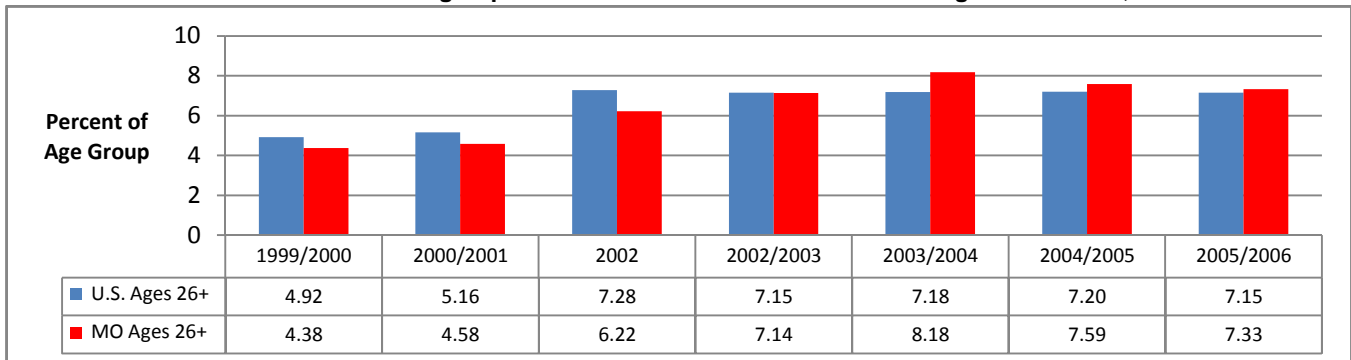

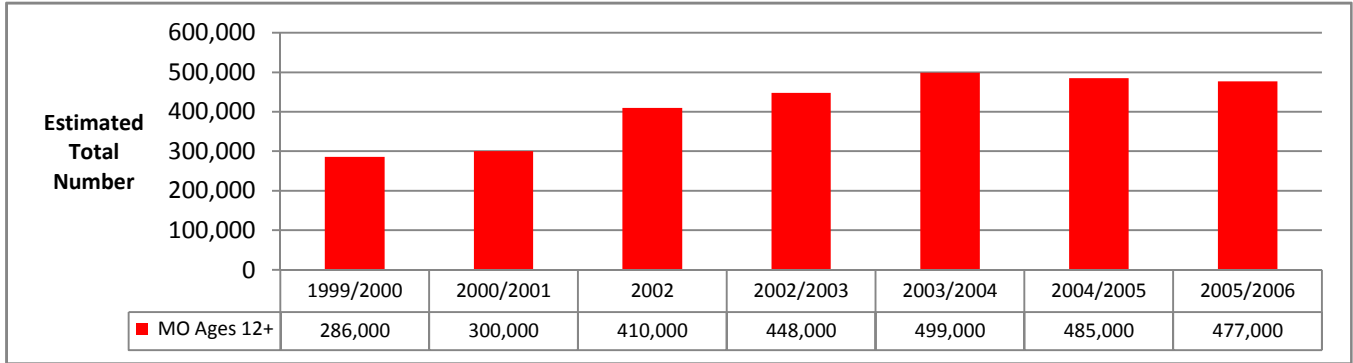

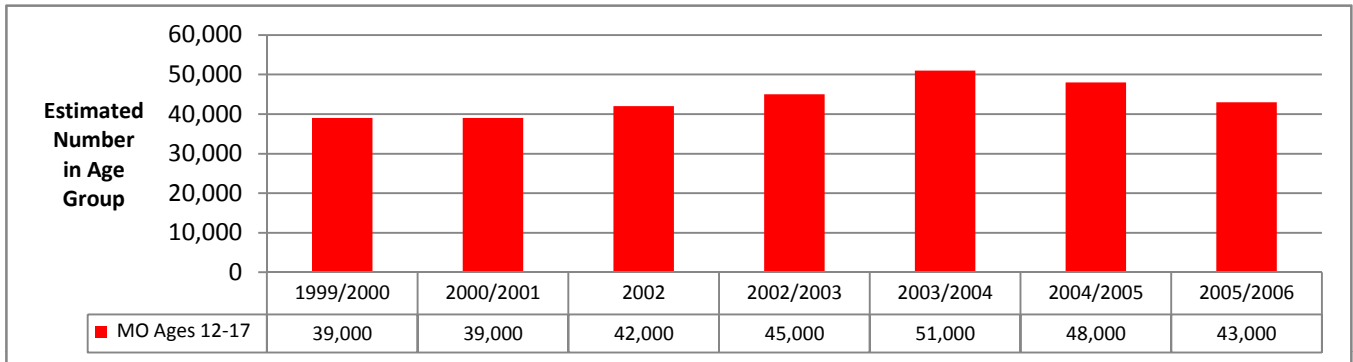

Estimated Number with Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse: Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 1999-2006



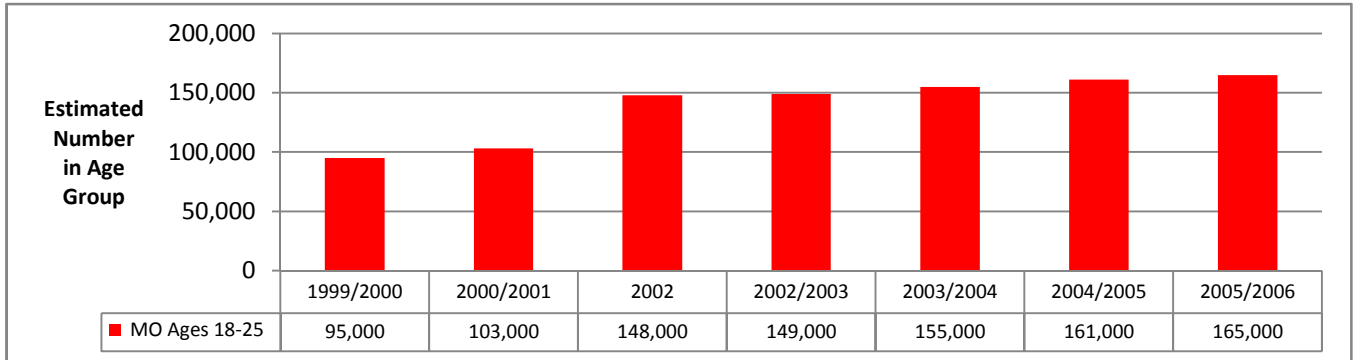

Estimated Number with Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse: Missouri Ages 12-17, 1999-2006



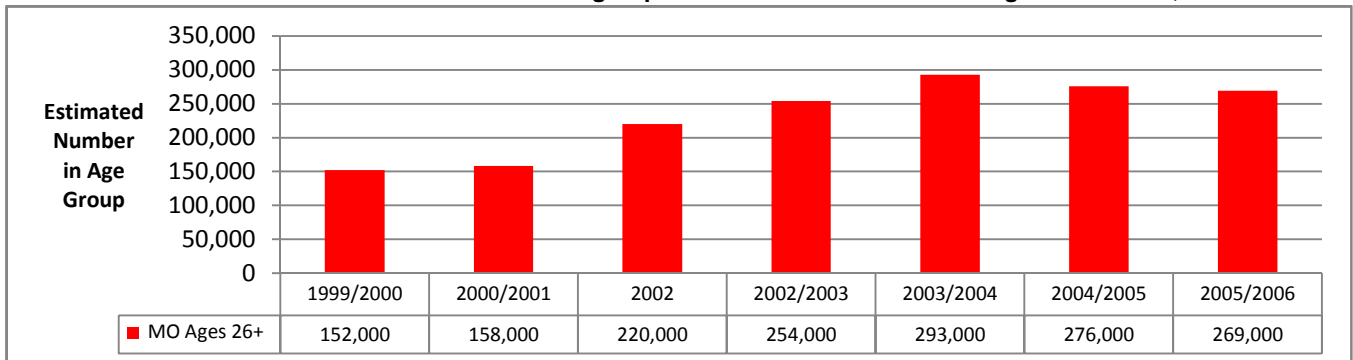

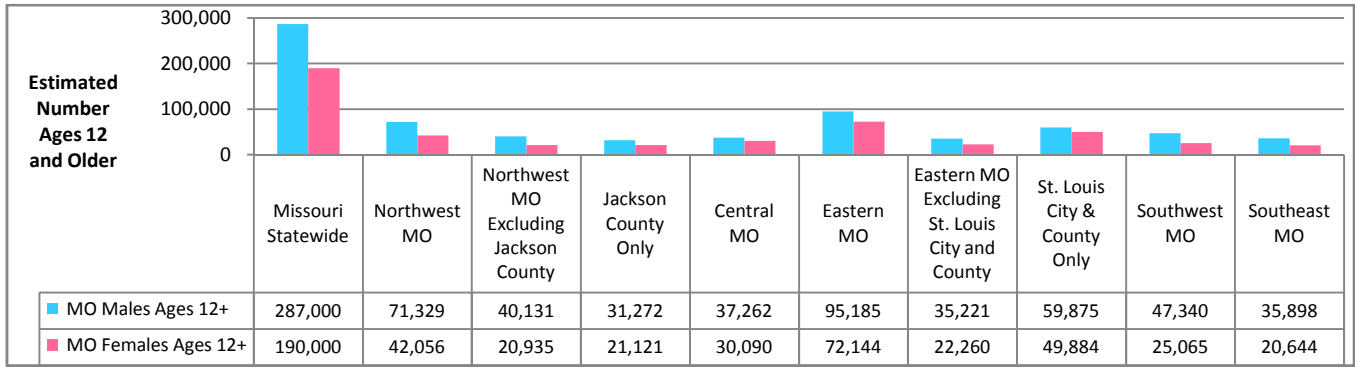

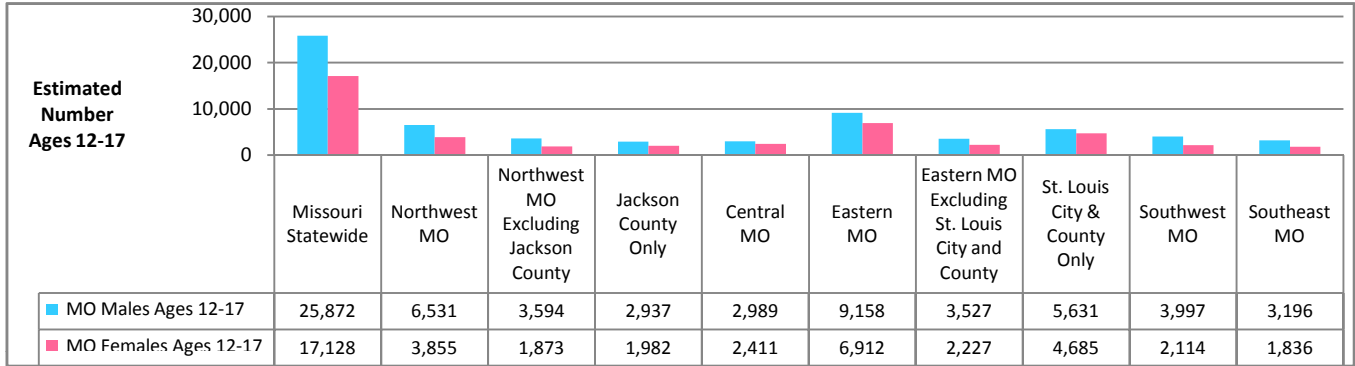

Estimated Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse: ADA Regions and Gender Ages 12 & Older, 2005/2006



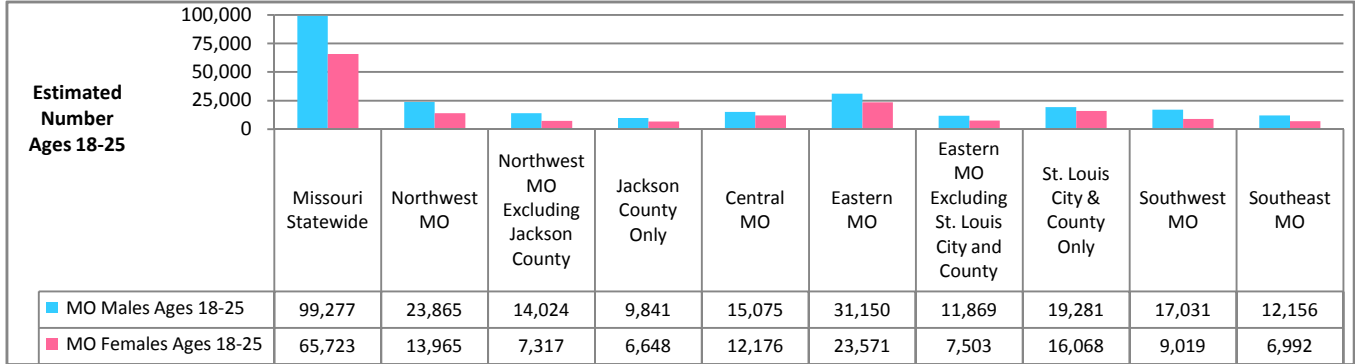

Estimated Past-Year Alcohol or Illicit Drug Dependence or Abuse: ADA Regions and Gender Ages 12-17, 2005/2006



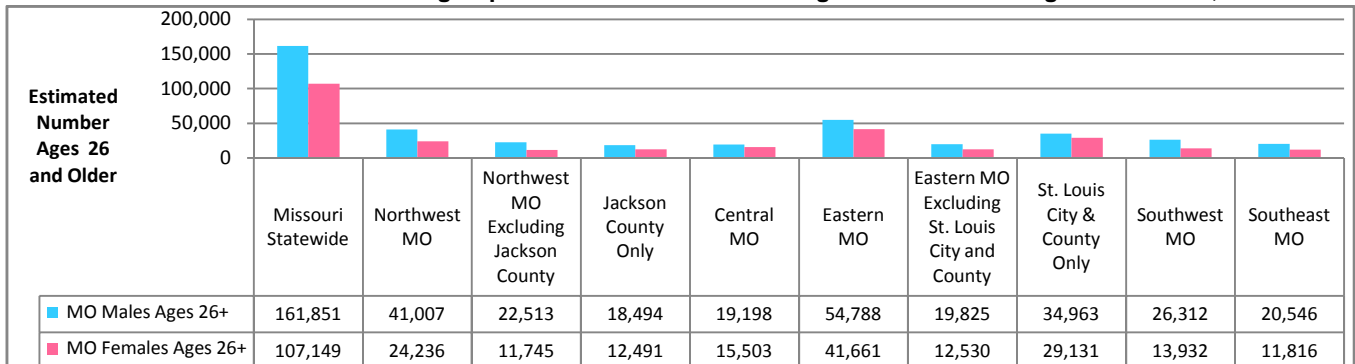

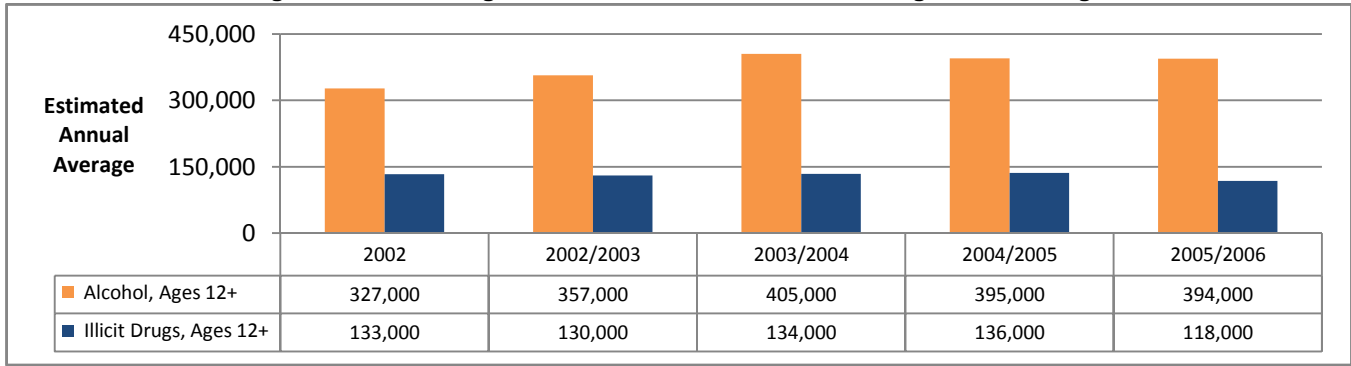

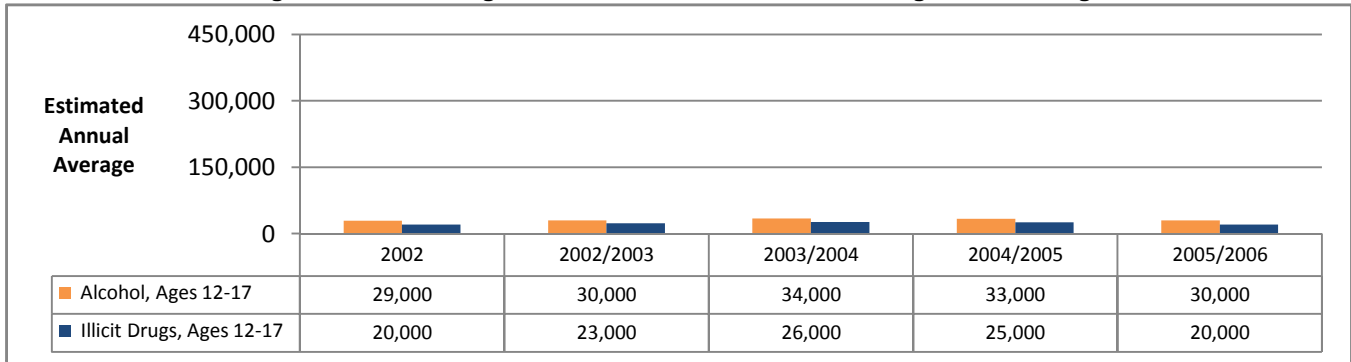

Estimated Number Needing but Not Receiving Treatment for Alcohol and Illicit Drugs: Missouri Ages 12 & Older, 2002-2006



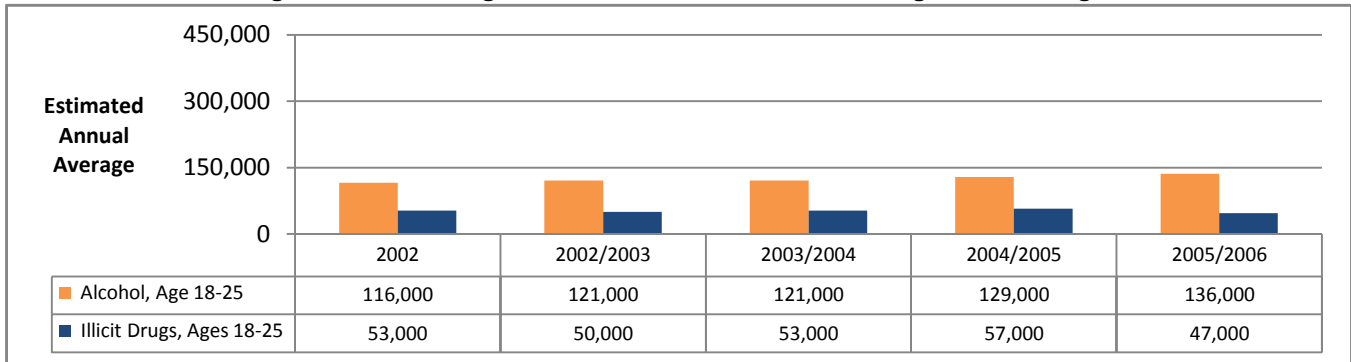

Estimated Number Needing but Not Receiving Treatment for Alcohol and Illicit Drugs: Missouri Ages 12-17, 2002-2006



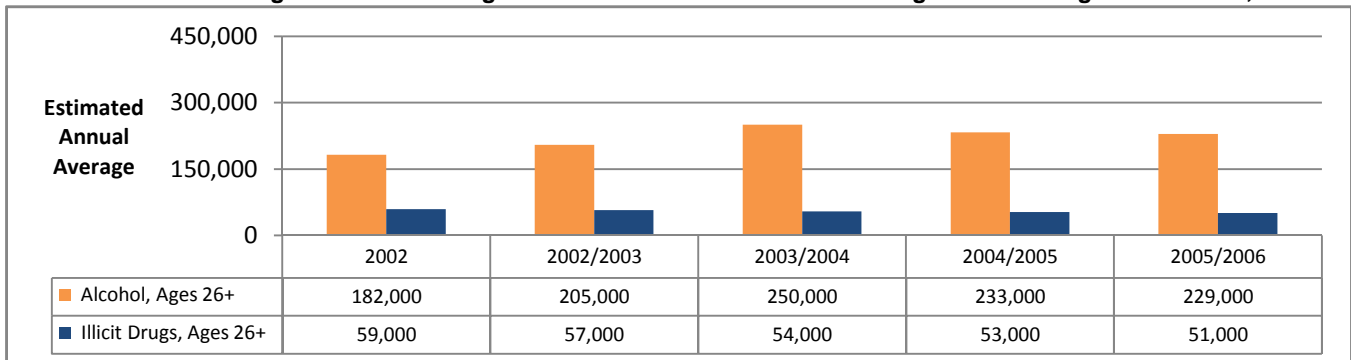

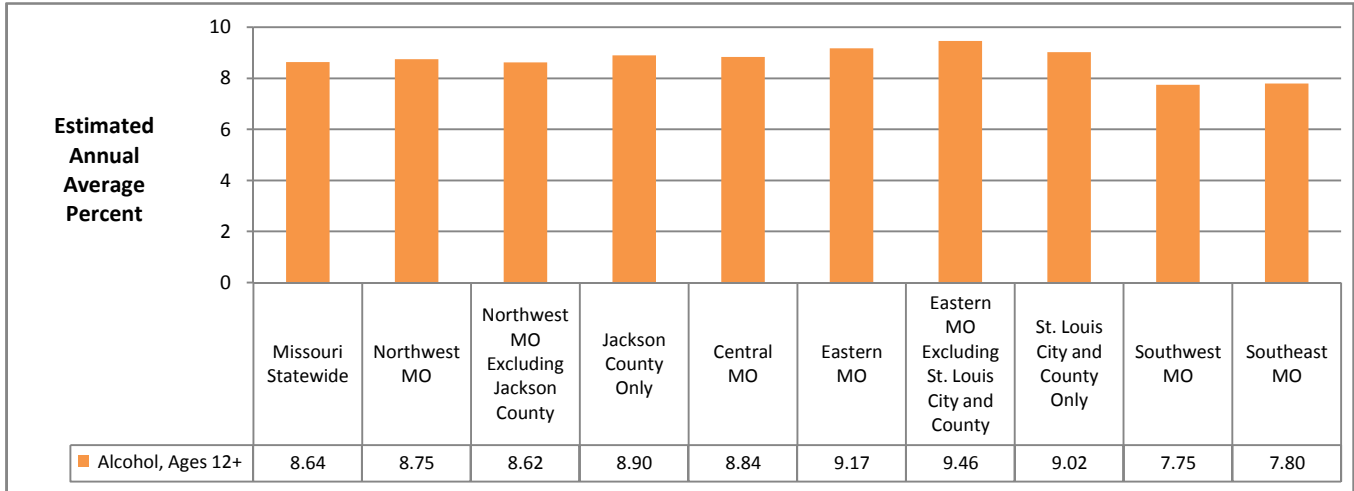
Estimated Number Needing but Not Receiving Treatment for Alcohol and Illicit Drugs: Missouri Ages 26 & Older, 2002-2006

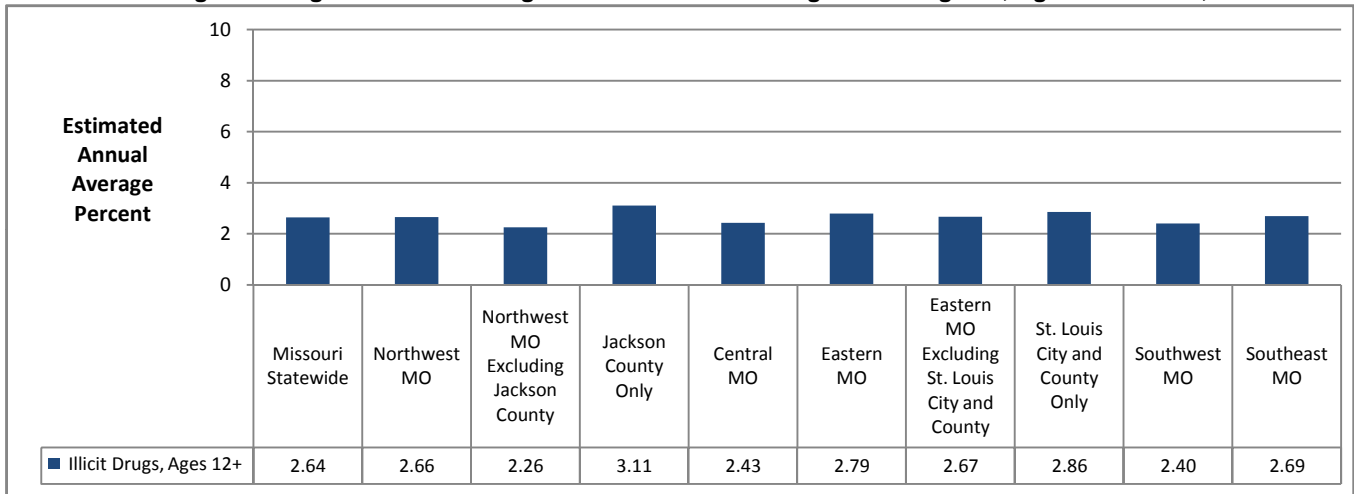
NEEDING BUT NOT RECEIVING SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT

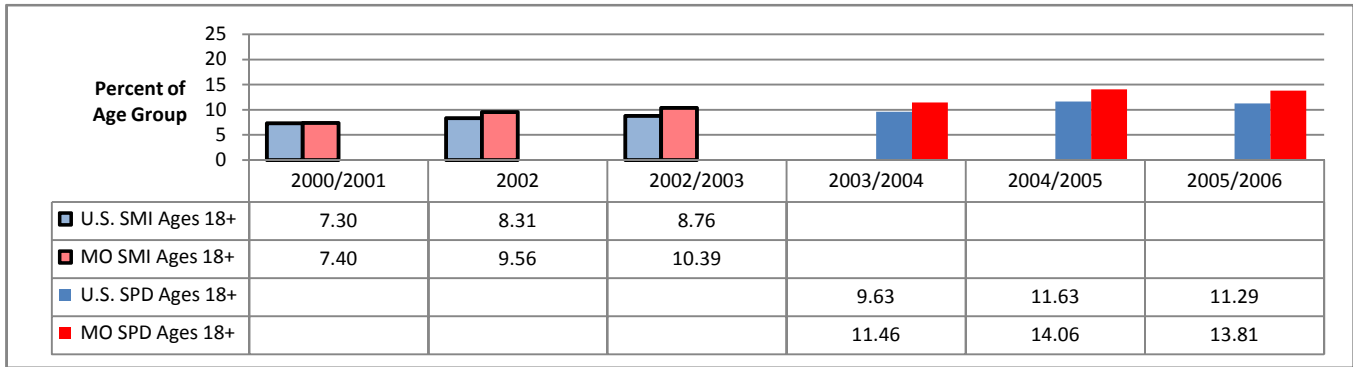
Estimated Percentage Needing but Not Receiving Treatment for Illicit Drugs: ADA Regions, Ages 12 & Older, 2004-2006

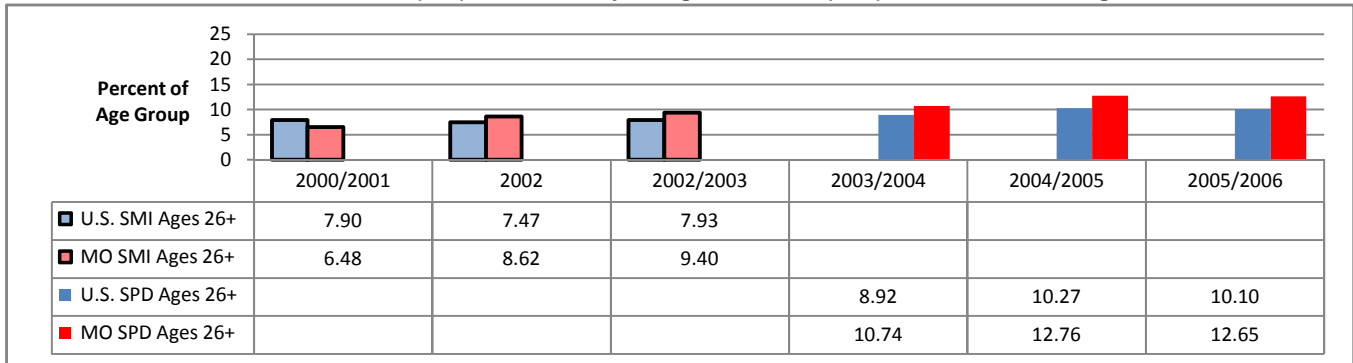

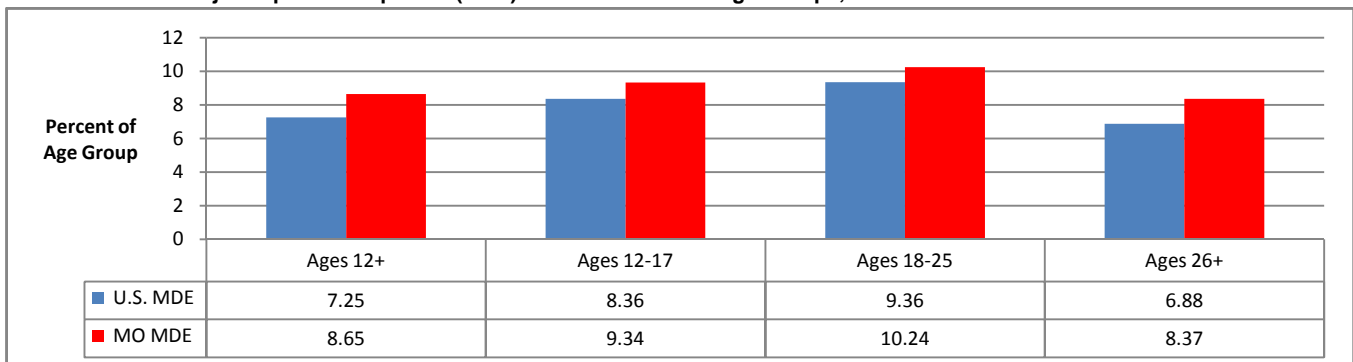
